#### From the Pastor's Office

#### Fourth Sunday of Easter

Before the early Christians could flourish in Jerusalem, there was the matter of the crucifixion of Jesus to deal with. At the trial you all cried out "Crucify Him!" You have the death of an innocent man on your hands. Peter explains that the whole thing was a set up. Peter called those responsible, "lawless men." All the Jews piled into the square to witness the trial. Most of them had no idea who Jesus from Nazareth was. They just wanted to enjoy the spectacle of a trial. Throughout history people have enjoyed many gruesome spectacles. People love a good hanging. They love an afternoon at the guillotine. They love a good bomb blast. In the midst of his speech, it was time for Peter to reveal Jesus to the crowd. "Let the whole house of Israel know for certain that God has made both Lord and Christ, this Jesus whom you crucified." In other words, know right now that this Jesus is

the Messiah you have all been waiting for. Naturally, the crowd gets upset. We didn't know. We just went along with it. We didn't know. What can we do now to rectify it? Peter invited them all to be baptized. They are all invited to become followers of Christ. There is lots of teaching, lots of testimony. It must have amazed all these Jews in the square that the Apostles did not hold any grudges against them. Properly you would expect the Apostles to condemn these stupid people. Look at the damage you have done! You are stupid people!! There was none of that. Gradually they were told that part of Jesus' divine plan was that He should die. His life would be ransomed for all the sins of the world. This was a saving act. No one guite understood the meaning until after the event. We remember that the Apostles could not accept the crucifixion either. Jesus gets all poetic in the gospel talking about a shepherd and his sheep. I think the shepherd image of Jesus is my favorite of them all. The shepherd and His sheep



have an intimate relationship with each other. We are the sheep. We feel safe and secure that our Shepherd is so devoted to us. He always watches over us. That is a huge consolation.

#### Happy Renew and Rejoice in His Spirit Campaign Kick-Off Weekend!

St. Catherine's is incredibly humbled to have your support in this monumental effort. Today, we officially kick-off our campaign to preserve our beloved sanctuary, re-invest in our parish, and support our diocese.

Thanks to an initial 135 gifts, St. Catherine of Siena parish families have raised over **\$1,800,000**, which is 30% of our ambitious \$6 Million goal. We will allocate our funds raised across 3 main initiatives:

**Sanctuary Renovations (\$2.8M)** – St. Catherine's is completely refurbishing our sanctuary to create a safe, welcoming, comfortable, and intentional space for our community to worship in. Among a long list of projects, St. Catherine's will be....

- Updating pews and kneelers
- Remodeling our bathrooms
- Preserving our cupola
- Replacing the HVAC system

**Retiring Parish Debt (\$1.5M)** – Additional reinvestment into our parish includes retiring lingering debt on the Parish Center. The Diocese of Austin's Encountering Christ Campaign (\$1.64M) – Our portion of the Encountering Christ campaign will go towards Supporting Clergy from seminary to retirement, Strengthening Parishes by supporting each parish's unique needs, growing Emerging Discipleship in campus and high school ministries, and Embracing Discipleship by funding leadership development and Catholic charities. 


