From the Pastor's Office

15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Pope Francis told a story about when he was Archbishop in Buenos Aires. His Church was the Cathedral, a church full of grandeur fit for an Archbishop. The building was full of architecture and paintings. Great Church liturgies were celebrated there. This is a church built for grand occasions. Pope Francis went on to tell us about the poor women of Buenos Aires who packed into the Church to pray at the altar to the Blessed Virgin Mary. They were robed in their shawls carrying their babies. They stood at the back out of the way when the Archbishop came to celebrate. Pope Francis said they barely understood what was happening. They did not understand his words when he spoke, but Pope Francis said that they understood the mysteries of God completely. They had little education, but they understood everything about the mystery of God. Jesus told his

Apostles that He spoke in parables so that the poor people might understand the mysteries. The Word of God is sown to us just like the sower who goes out and scatters his seed. Most of the seed goes to waste because it falls on soil that is unable to gather it and put it in the ground. So much of the wisdom of God is lost because we don't know how to gather it. The great scholars of the world spend their days gathering the seed. They know what to do with it. They know all about the soil and how much rain is necessary for the seed to grow. Most of us are fluffing about all over the place. Then you come upon the poor women of the barrios. They come down into the city because the Archbishop is celebrating Mass at the Cathedral. They come early to have their special place in the Church. Before the Archbishop arrives, they make their way to Mother Mary's altar to place their petitions. Then they position themselves so they can get a good view of the Archbishop. The dignitaries and

important people process into the Church and some underling escorts them to their

seats. The choir bellows in song. The people rise to see the Archbishop process into the Church. Great words are proclaimed. Major choirs sing the hymns. Yet all the time, the humble women of the city sit quietly at the sides reciting their rosaries, offering their prayers for their children, begging God to look upon them with His mercy. The light of God shines on them. When it is all over, the women go away quietly to climb the mountain again, home to their little houses. Meanwhile the Archbishop accompanied by the important people go to the hotel for lunch. Another day at the Cathedral.

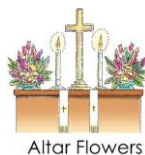

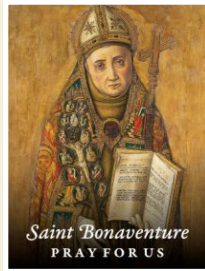

Feast Day of St. Bonaventure

On July 15 we celebrate the feast day of St. Bonaventure, one of the Doctors of the Church. St. Bonaventure, who was baptized John, was born in Italy in 1221. It is said that in his youth he suffered from a serious bowel disorder and that he was cured through the intercession of St. Francis of Assisi. John joined the Franciscan Order at the age of 22, and at that time he took the name of Bonaventure.



Bonaventure was a teacher and a prolific writer. He is known as the "Seraphic Doctor" of the Church, a reference to his profound and mystical writings, the most famous of which is *The Soul's Journey into God*. Bonaventure served as the General Minister of the Franciscan Orders of Friars Minor for 17 years, and through his diligent study, leadership and writings, he brought unity to the Franciscans in the midst of conflict. Bonaventure died suddenly on July 15, 1274, after being named a Cardinal and appointed Bishop of Albano.

In this Sunday's Gospel from Matthew we hear of "...the seed sown on rich soil is the one who hears the word and understands it, who indeed bears fruit...". Through his zealous love for Jesus and his devoted service and guidance of the Franciscan Order, Bonaventure produced spiritual fruit that we can still enjoy today. St. Bonaventure, pray for us!

- **FAMILY FAITH COORDINATOR** (*full-time position*)

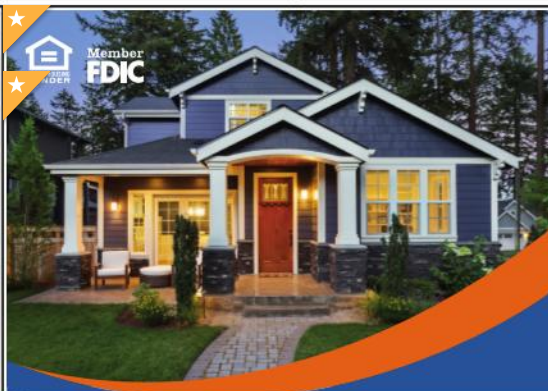

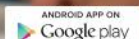
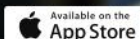
