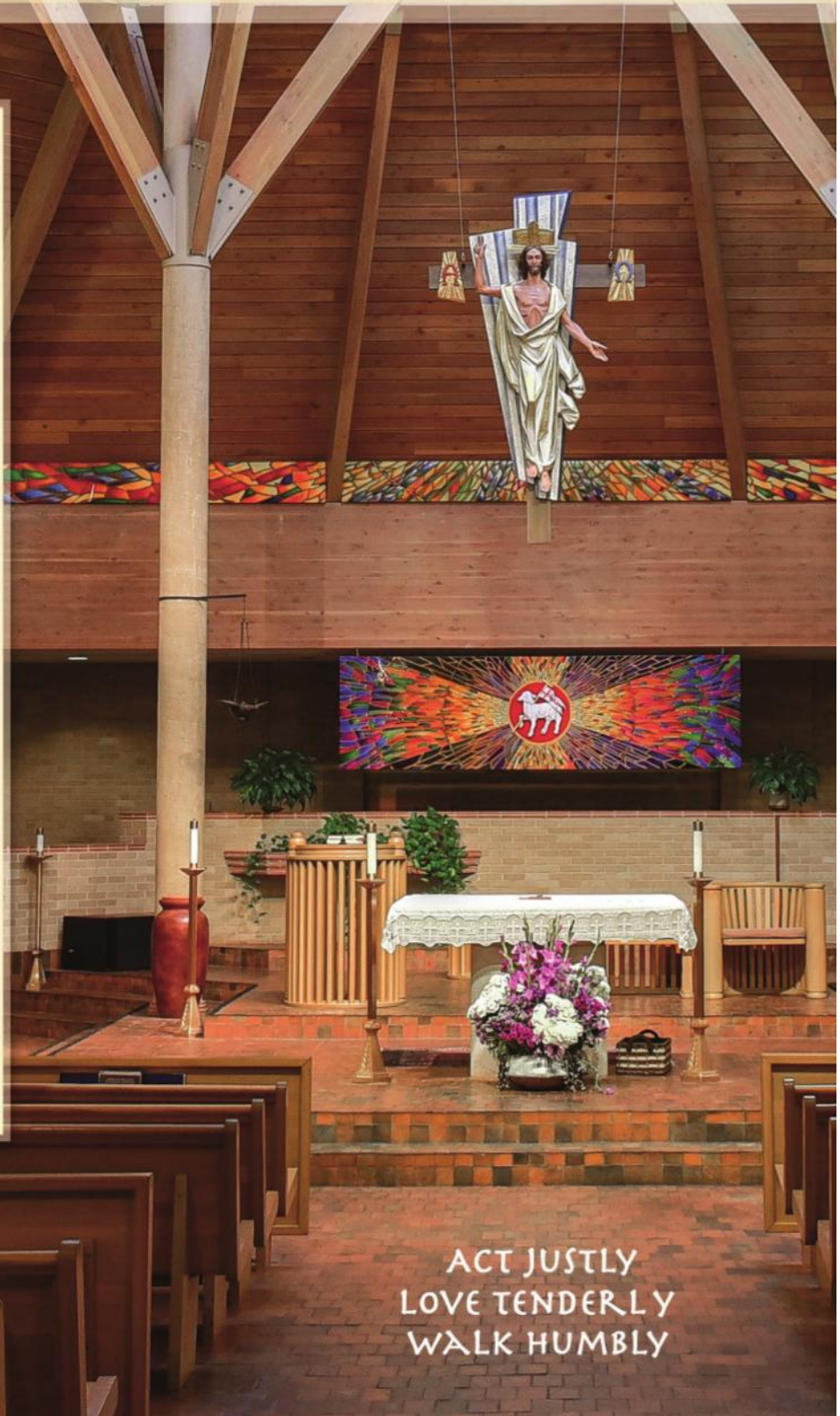

From the Pastor's Office

17th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Solomon was the King of ancient Israel. He was also the son and successor of King David. He was a good man. We have heard of the wisdom of Solomon. The first lesson today gives us an understanding as to why Solomon was wise. He found it hard to be a king. He felt a huge responsibility. He is honest before God. "O Lord, my God, you have made me, your servant, king to secede my father David, but I am a mere youth, not knowing at all how to act." You kind of imagine people like Solomon, people like King Charles III must have a good idea of how to be a King. There is no school to learn how to be a King. You kind of learn as you go. Solomon asks God to teach him how to be a good King. God heard his prayer and promises him that he will have a heart that will be wise and understanding. Well, that's a good start. Jesus is busy teaching the people about the Kingdom

of Heaven. What is it like? I think at one time or another we have all wondered what Heaven is like. We try to put shape on this immensity called Heaven. It sounds like the Kingdom of Heaven is all things to all people. So, I guess there is a dog heaven, a cat heaven, a goldfish heaven, and a bird heaven. I don't know. I don't know



everything you know. But Jesus has me guessing all the same. Somewhere out there in the blue yonder there is God, and I wonder about Him. What is God like? I guess one day I will find out.

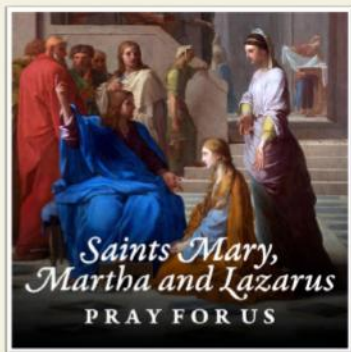

Memorial of Saints Martha, Mary, and Lazarus

On Saturday, July 29, we celebrate the memorial of Saints Martha, Mary, and Lazarus. Martha, Mary, and Lazarus were siblings who lived in the town of Bethany, very close to Jerusalem on the Mount of Olives. They were close friends with Jesus, and during one visit to their house Jesus famously declared "Mary has chosen the better part", referring to Mary's decision to sit at the feet of Jesus and listen to Him speak rather than serving Him with worry as Martha did. In Chapter 11 of the Gospel of John we read that Jesus' beloved friend, Lazarus, dies. Jesus goes to the tomb of Lazarus, who had died four days earlier and commands "Lazarus, come out!". Lazarus obeys and "the dead man came out..." In this weekend's Responsorial Psalm, we sing "Lord, I love your commands." May we all learn to serve God with the intensity of Martha, listen to the words of God with the devotion of Mary, and follow the commands of God with the obedience of Lazarus. Saints Martha, Mary and Lazarus, pray for us!

The Family Faith Formation department is hiring for the following positions:

- **FAMILY FAITH COORDINATOR** (*full-time position*)

Retrouvaille Weekend

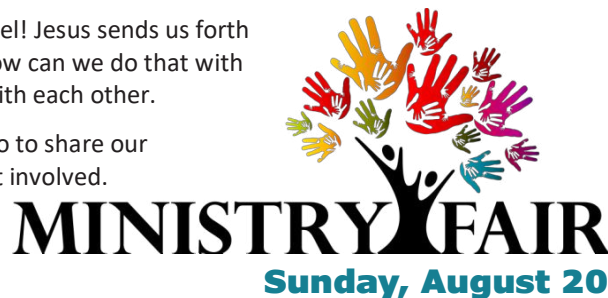

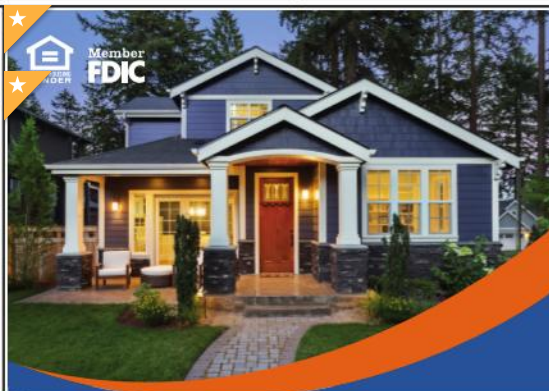
