#### From the Pastor's Office

#### 30th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The only time I have ever been referred to as an alien was when I applied for my green card to enter America legally. I will never forget my first entry into this country. I was on route to my first assignment in Venezuela and I was stopping off in New York to visit my cousins, a small vacation before I went to work. I will never forget my first entry through customs. A very serious police official greeted me. He inspected my papers. I was sweating like crazy. I was dressed like a priest. He told me that he wanted to ask me one question. If I answered it properly I could enter the United States. I was sweating more like crazy. This was the question on which my whole life hinged. "What were the names of Adam and Eve's children?" For a millisecond I freaked out and then I answered. With a warm smile I was welcomed to America. (His little joke.) I sympathize with the people of Exodus who were reminded that once they were called "aliens." That is a way of saying you have no fixed abode. You live outside laws and jurisdictions. First, we must get you sorted. Jesus stands before the customs officials in Jerusalem to answer their questions. Their question asks, "Which commandment is the greatest?" Previously, we are told Jesus silenced the Sadducees. No doubt they had questions of their own to ask. I suspect, we can deduct, that Jesus did not suffer fools gladly. He didn't like to play their games. All their questions were designed to trap Jesus. We want to make a fool out of him. We want the people to see Him as He really is. We want the people to regard us as guardians of the people. We are the good guys and He is the bad guy. Jesus never flinched. He never backed away from a question. Which commandment is the greatest? Jesus answered directly. The thing we can say about Jesus is that we know what we are getting. He never



held back when what He had to say was difficult. Love your enemies. Let your enemy slap you. Give to the poor. Be forgiving all the time. Jesus was never looking for the popular vote. We know that because they killed Him for all the things He said. But, if Jesus ever became a political candidate, He was a man who meant what He said, and He said what He meant.




