From the Pastor's Office

4th Sunday in Ordinary Time

There is a lot of talk about prophecy in the popular media right now. Coming into the new year we hear news talking about famous prophets like Nostradamus. Then there is that blind lady from Eastern Europe, Baba Vanga. Recently I heard about a new one from Brazil. Along with that, we have all kinds of oddities. There are people who claim they have come back from the future to warn us that we are heading to catastrophe. I could have told them that myself. I don't need a prophet to tell me. More, there are photos published of people from the past carrying cell phones to their ears. I thought all this access to media today was to make our lives better, and more informed. Instead, there are crackpots with sinister motives trying to frighten us to death. I don't like to be manipulated by anyone. How does anybody know that what they are saying is true? In the world of spirituality, we talk about discernment. Discernment is about trying to discover

what God is saying to us. Moses was very severe about false prophets in the first lesson today. Listen to this, "If a prophet presumes to speak in my name an oracle that I have not commanded him to speak, or speaks in the name of other gods, he shall die." There are plenty of prophets in our world today. Most of them do not speak anything that is god sent. Jesus visited the synagogue in Capernaum and He was invited to say a few words. Jesus was very controversial. It is ironic that the god-fearing people couldn't fathom Him. It was a man with an unclean spirit who recognized Him. "What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? I know who you are, the Holy One of God." In the world of discernment, of God speaking to us, we have to be careful what we say. I might be very sincere but I can be easily misinterpreted. Mass Schedule Change on Friday, February 2

On Friday, February 2, we will have a **Communion Service** at noon instead of Daily Mass. We will offer the **Anointing of the Sick** at the noon Mass on Friday, February 9, the second Friday of the month instead of our usual first Friday of the month.

The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord (Candlemas), Friday, February 2

On the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, we hear the words of Simeon in the temple, proclaiming the infant Jesus as a light to all the world. Traditionally, all the candles used in church and the ones we will use at home throughout the year are brought to the church to be blessed. On Friday, February 2, you are invited to bring to the noon Communion Service your candles for use at home. Please bring your candles and place them in front of the altar before the Service to be blessed.

Memorial of Saint Blaise and Blessing of the Throats

Legend tells us that St. Blaise cured a young boy choking on a fish bone. We ask for St. Blaise's intercession of healing or keeping us free from any illness or injury to our throats. Blessing of the Throats will be given immediately following the noon Mass on Monday, February 5.

Music Ministries

So what's with the Latin?

In weeks to come, we will sing a different set of acclamations during the Liturgy of the Eucharist – three of them, plus a very short 'Amen.' Lovely and simple, these acclamations have been part of Catholic worship for hundreds of years. Some of



them may already be familiar. Sung without instruments, each is very brief – ideal for learning as we go. All are taken from the church's traditional Latin chant.

While it may seem odd to sing in another language, we already do so when we sing the Kyrie in Greek! Many find that, once they understand what is being sung, the beauty and simplicity of the music can help bring an enhanced quality of worship. Chant's ethereal quality is very appropriate to the mysteries of the Eucharist. Our liturgies were sung in this way for centuries, and singing this music is a way to further connect our prayer with that of countless believers throughout the ages.

While it is not our plan to make this music a year-round part of our worship at Saint Catherine, it is hoped that the community will benefit from its periodic presence: that by taking part in this small sampling of ancient sacred music, we might experience

these prayers in a different way, broaden our ideas on worship, and deepen our appreciation for the many treasures of our Catholic faith. For additional information, scan this QR code or visit stcatherine-austin.org/latin-acclamations-2024.


