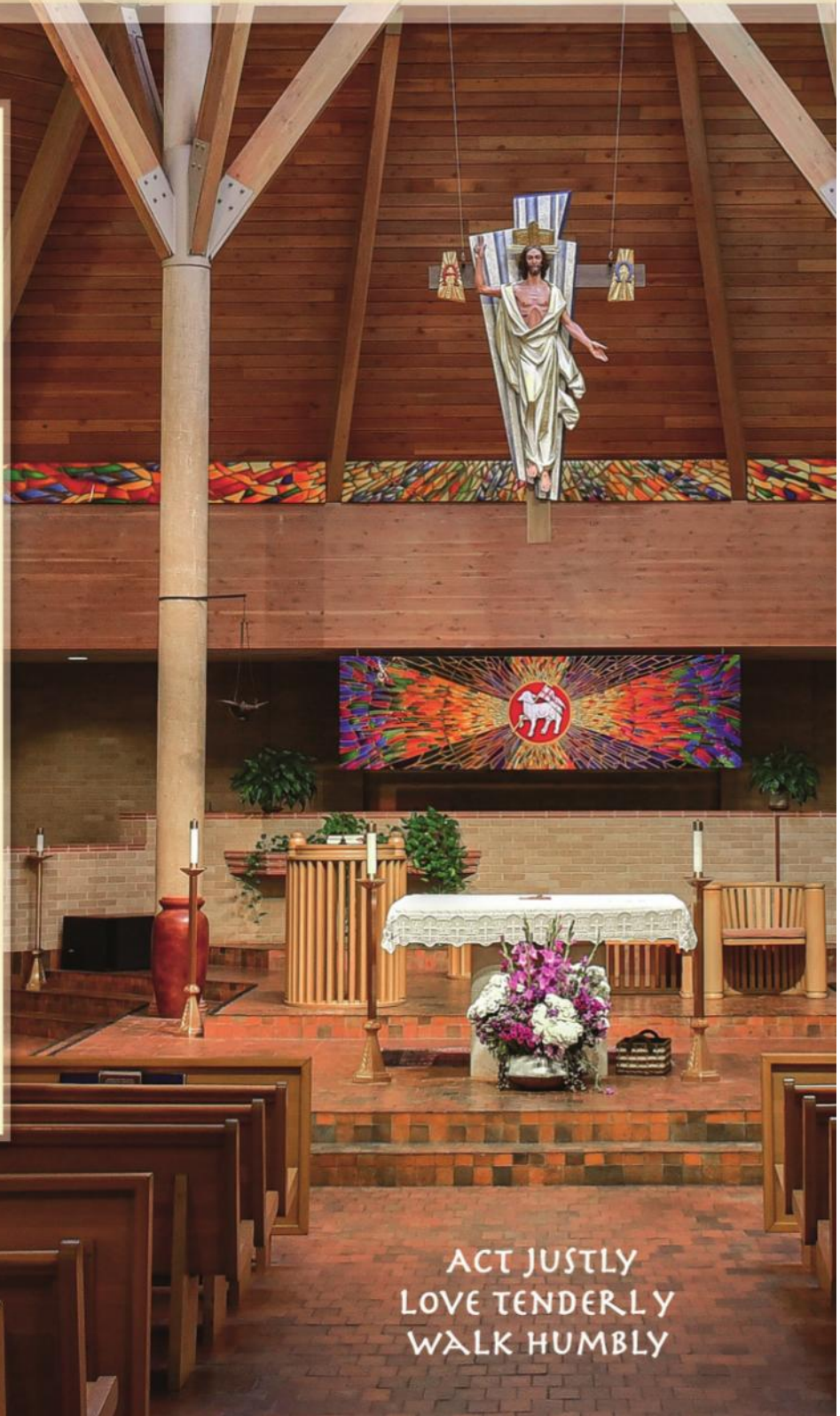

From the Pastor's Office

2nd Sunday of Lent

We are asked to consider the Transfiguration today. We are well familiar with the story. Jesus brought some of His apostles with Him up the mountain. Clearly this was meant to be one of those silence in the desert experiences. A time to pray. While they were up there Jesus was transfigured before them. Quietly I think about all those ladies in the dress shops, especially the bridal gown shops. The bride-to-be goes into the dressing room to put on her first wedding dress. Then she comes out and everyone gasps at her beauty. She is transformed into beauty. Jesus was

transformed, transfigured before their eyes. He showed His divinity to them. The Divine Son showed Himself as dressed in brilliant white. All around Him stood Heavenly beings, watching over Him. Liturgy

Each liturgical season offers a different kind of beauty.

Violet, the color of this season is incorporated into the spaces to enhance what is most essential during this season: the ambo, altar, font, and cross. At St. Catherine, we replace the Risen Christ on the Cross with the traditional crucifix. All remind us that this is a season of repentance, a time to turn our life around and journey toward holiness.

Our Parish Lenten Penance Service will be held on Tuesday, February 27, at 7:30 p.m. following the 7:00 p.m. Mass. Fr. Pat, Fr. Ray, and Fr. Lou, along with other priests from the diocese will be available for individual confessions.



Stations of the Cross

Join us on the Friday Nights of Lent at 7:00 p.m. for Stations of the Cross. Mass follows immediately after the Stations for those who wish to remain. The parish also has Stations of the Cross outside on the grounds for you to walk and pray in private prayer.

Fasting and Abstinence during Lent

On the Fridays of Lent, it is the obligation of practicing Catholics from age 14 onward to abstain from eating meat. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of both fasting and abstinence. On days of fasting, Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are permitted to eat one full meal and two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. On days of fasting, refrain from eating between the permitted meals.
