From the Pastor's Office

4th Sunday of Lent

I don't care how wonderful the Pharisees and Priests were in ancient Israel. Shame on them all for victimizing this poor man. Shame and victimization is a practice that exists to this very day. People want to score their political points to win and they will say anything, truth and lies, to win. Good decent people are dragged before the public places and used and abused at the pleasure of others. This man was blind and vulnerable. He depended on the goodness of other people to survive. There were no social services to reach out to him. Ancient Israel was full of the wounded and the maimed. They wandered about trying to survive another day. On top of that, place all the abandoned women and children who had to fend for themselves. In many quarters, even today, the world is a cruel place. I read this the other day. In our Western society, we are so driven to look beautiful, to dress in our modern smart clothes, that we dump our leftovers in parts of Africa

and Asia. Poor people wear our castoffs. They use our used goods while we go out and buy more nonsense. Goodwill is the most popular store in every city in America. This blind man belonged to the throngs who walked the streets until this day he came upon a kind Rabbi called Jesus from Nazareth. Straight away the Pharisees were on it. Clearly, their agenda was to condemn Jesus. It didn't matter what He said or did, their job was to condemn Him in every way they could. After that, they condemned anyone who associated with Him. The poor blind man and his parents were subjected to some awful scrutiny. They just wanted to get on with their lives. Instead, these people, with their swanky clothes interrogated them and frightened them to death. They wanted the blind man to recant. Say that this never happened. Jesus of Nazareth is a bad person and shame on everyone who has anything to do with Him. There is a story brewing in Washington right now. A famous politician and his son have been condemned in the public arena for

wrongdoing and lies. They have been paraded through the media and we are all persuaded to take sides and fire our



insults against them for their corruption. It turns out, in the news tonight, that the originator of these accusations lied about everything. He confessed. The blind man and his parents deserve our apology for the abuse they had to endure. It was only natural, after such a miracle that this family wanted to celebrate and rejoice. Instead, they were made into pawns in a political game of win and lose. If you scratch the skin of good decent people, with some of them, you find a rat living underneath. Sad.


