

From the Pastor's Office

Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles

I suspect Peter and Paul never worked together much probably because they were like chalk and cheese. Based on what we know, during the time Peter went about with Jesus he had a lot to say and often what he did say was best forgotten. I still remember Peter on the mountain when Jesus was transfigured, instead of trying to grasp the deeper meaning Peter suggested they put up tents. Peter was the one who promised never to deny Jesus but instead he denied him three times. Paul was a different type entirely. He was like a wild colt who needed to be set free so that he could soar. Paul never thought of himself as a great orator, but boy could he soar. He seemed to have boundless energy. Nothing could stop him from preaching the word of Jesus. I love passionate people. I love people who

stretch themselves and go above and beyond what is expected of them. My favorite moment with Peter was when they all went out fishing and then they saw their Lord on the shore making breakfast. This is the place where Jesus asked Peter if he loved him. Peter was beaten down and humbled. Him and his big mouth. He was embarrassed and didn't know how to face Jesus. Gradually Jesus reeled him back in and they were good again. I love how Paul went about on his missionary journeys to all kinds of wild remote places. It wasn't all successful. There must have been some very difficult days. But Paul was relentless. He kept going. He went into the community of Corinth and the people resented him as an outsider coming to interfere with their version of Christianity. Paul put them right and that was the end of it. If they didn't like it, they knew where to go. We are not accustomed to celebrating the feast of

Peter and Paul on a Sunday, but I am glad. It is good to herald our great biblical heroes. It helps us to connect



with them. They were not just saints. They were regular folks like us, doing the best they could. They succeeded and they failed. God bless them.

Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles. Why does the Church designate a solemnity, a celebration of the greatest importance, for Saints Peter and Paul?

In Matthew 16:18-19, Jesus says to Peter (formerly known as Simon) "...you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church, and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it. I will give you the keys to the kingdom of heaven." Thus, Peter was made the first pope.

Paul is credited with writing 13 of the 27 books in the New Testament, and through his writings Paul is considered to be one of the most influential figures in Christianity. Paul, formerly known as Saul, is known as the "Apostle to the Gentiles".

Both St. Peter and St. Paul are considered pillars of the Church, and both gave their lives as martyrs. Yet, we read in the Gospels that Peter denied Jesus not once or twice, but three times. We also read in the New Testament of Paul persecuting Christians. How did these two men, who both turned their backs on Jesus, gain such an important place in the Church? The answer is only through the grace of God, and His infinite mercy and willingness to find goodness in the midst of darkness. May we take comfort and find hope in the stories of two sinners, used by God to glorify His Kingdom, and through God's grace may we grow willing to give our lives entirely to His service. St. Peter and St. Paul, pray for us!

Parish Communications Update

The digital bulletin will be accessible through the <u>parish website</u> and weekly update emails, which are sent out every Saturday. If you are not receiving the weekly update emails, please <u>sign up online</u> or contact <u>Danielle Nepustil</u> in the parish office. The My Parish App will also no longer be updated, since it is part of the services we have received from the company that prints our bulletin.

We will also switch our parish email distribution system from Flocknote to Connect, which is run by eCatholic, the company that manages our website. This will take place over the remainder of the summer. If you are already receiving weekly emails from the parish, you should be automatically transferred to the new system. You may have noticed screens located in the narthex, the Parish Center and the Administration Building. We are now using a digital signage system to help promote upcoming events and feature other elements about our parish, the diocese and the Catholic church. Please contact Danielle Nepustil in the parish office if you have questions about the digital bulletin, the email distribution system or the digital signage. Thank you for your patience as we make these transitions.


