From the Pastor's Office

20th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Poor the Prophet Jeremiah. They called him "the reluctant Prophet." So would you be when you consider the life he lived as a prophet. The Royal court of that time was completely corrupted. People were grasping power all over the place. God called Jeremiah, against his will, to go to the Royal Court and speak God's words to the King. Naturally, the corrupted King didn't want to know about it, so he ordered that Jeremiah be punished to death. Basically they threw him down a well to die. No mercy. Thank God for Ebed-Melech the court official. At least he had a grain of compassion. He pleaded with the King to be merciful to Jeremiah. Jeremiah had no food or water. He would die down there. Eventually the King relented and set Jeremiah free. Paul says in his letter today that we are surrounded by a cloud of witnesses. Ebed was one of those for Jeremiah. The world can be cold-hearted. The world can forget very easily

when we are in trouble and we need help. There are people out there and their sixth sense tells them that I am in trouble and I need help. These are my guardian angels and I thank God for them. Jesus sounds pretty mad in the gospel today. No wonder they condemned Him to death. He invited his followers to become cannibals eating His flesh and drinking His blood. Now He wants to wage war on the world. He wants everyone to die. He wants families to turn against each other. This can't be true, because we have seen other aspects of Jesus. We saw Him sitting with the woman at the well, how compassionate He was. We saw Him curing the paralyzed man. How many blind people did He cure? We know that the way of Jesus was to be peace loving, peace giving. So, what on earth Jesus!? What are you telling us? Jesus calls us to repentance. It is time to make changes. Enough with hating the whole world. It is time for us to fix our world. There is plenty of hatred going about. Prophets of doom exist everywhere. It is time for all of

us to roll up our sleeves and get in there and help. Your world needs you!!

Mission Appeal This Weekend: August 16-17



St. Catherine of Siena is deeply honored to welcome **Most Rev. Dr. Johannes Gorantla, O.C.D.**, the Bishop of the Diocese of Kurnool, India, who will be preaching at all Masses this weekend, August 16-17. Bishop Johannes is a man of deep prayer, wisdom, and unshakable faith. Born on February 27, 1974, in a small village in southern India, he entered the Discalced Carmelite Order, professed solemn vows in 2000, and was ordained a priest in 2002. With a profound love for the Word of God, he earned his Doctorate in Biblical Theology from the prestigious Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome. He fluently speaks eight languages and has shared the Gospel with people from many cultures across the world. In 2024 he was appointed Bishop of Kurnool, where Catholics represent less than 1% of the population. Despite many challenges, Bishop Johannes leads a vibrant missionary diocese committed to educating over 1,500 poor children, offering medical care to the underprivileged, empowering women, and evangelizing in some of the most spiritually needy regions of India. His 20 years of priestly ministry include national and international service, rooted in humility, learning, and love for God's people. Come and be inspired by a true shepherd who embodies the spirit of the Gospel and the mission of the Church. Let us welcome Bishop Johannes with open hearts and joyful faith!

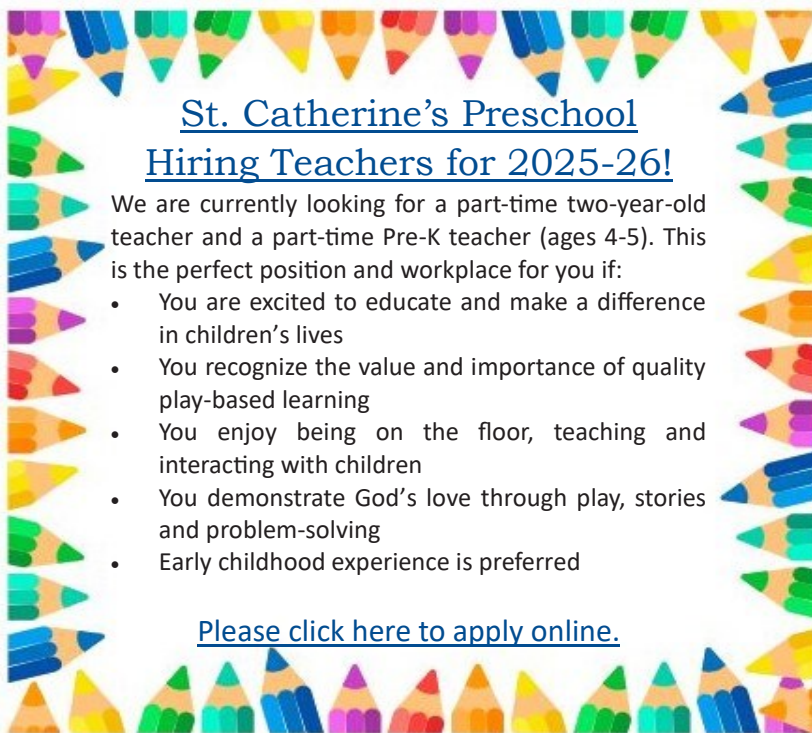

Food Drive a Big Success! Read the letter from Abiding Love

Dear Friends,
Abiding Love Food Pantry has been serving neighbors in need of food since January 2005. In about 2008, St. Catherine's began to help with this community service project by conducting food drives to support the pantry. Your support with food and volunteers has helped us serve an increasing number of families. Each week we have a volunteer staff of about 70 people.

Approximately one-third of those volunteers are members of St. Catherine of Siena. This support helps to allow us to serve on average over 190 families every Monday. In the past 7 months alone, we have served 5,234 families or 24,173 individuals.

The food drive on July 27 and August 3, which was spearheaded by the Knights of Columbus in coordination with St. Catherine's, collected 4,241 pounds of food and nonfood over the two weeks. When neighbors come to our drive-through pantry, they are given a shopping list of available food items. Because of your food drive, we were able to add a few items to our Client Shopping List that we would not have been able to offer without the large number of donations.

Our pantry is successful in helping our neighbors because of the donated food and monetary donations and because of the many St. Catherine volunteers who work each week in service of our community. We thank you for your donations and support of our efforts to provide for families in our community who are food insecure.

Religious Education Registration Open for 2025-2026

[Religious education registration](#) is open for the 2025-2026 school year. For grades 1-6, there are two options:



First Communion Registration

First Communion is a two-year program. Families who are going into their second year have already been contacted with registration information. If this will be your child's first year preparing for First Communion (grade 1 or higher), we will be doing registration in-person. We're going old school this year because we want to get to know families better and build parish community. **If you have a child who needs to begin their first year of First Communion preparation**, e-mail their baptism certificate and the date you completed the diocesan [EIM/VIRTUS](#) workshop to marti.salas@stcatherine-austin.org. If they were baptized here at St. Catherine's, let Marti know and she will look it up. After that, you will be sent a sign-up for a time to come in and register.

Post-First Communion Registration

Grades 7-12 Pre-Confirmation and Confirmation

Parents of students in grades 7-12 who are interested in Pre-Confirmation or Confirmation classes must schedule a meeting with Livia Telles-Rodriguez before registering. Meetings can be scheduled by [clicking here](#) or scanning the QR code.



Pre-Confirmation: Two years of pre-Confirmation classes are required before a student can attend Confirmation class. Pre-Confirmation classes can begin as early as grade 7. There are two options this year for pre-Confirmation: Sunday youth classes at St. Catherine of Siena twice a month **OR** at-home homework. Everyone must attend Sunday Mass twice a month and attend parish events.

Confirmation: Students in Confirmation class have completed two years of pre-Confirmation and are in grade 9 or above. Confirmation class will take place on Sundays in-person at St. Catherine of Siena for one semester. Everyone in Confirmation class must attend Sunday Mass twice a month and attend parish events.

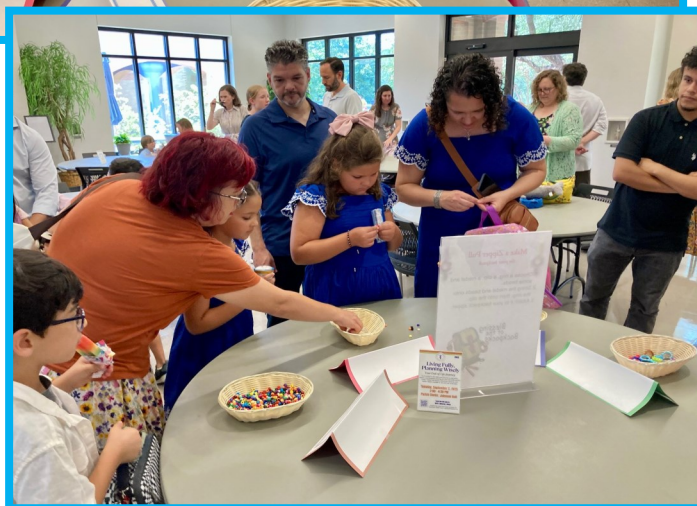
