

From the Pastor's Office

23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

I am very proud of our Catholic tradition. The Catholic world has contributed great things to the world. It was the Church that developed the institutions we call Universities, Hospitals and Scientific inquiry. The Church has contributed greatly to the traditions of art, music and learning. We have much to be proud of. I marvel at our great Catholic institutions, the great religious orders. Find a bunch of fanatical people with the same point of view, face them all in the same direction, give them a mission and watch them achieve. Those are the Franciscans, Dominicans, Jesuits, and a thousand other Orders of men and women. In order to be

focused and dedicated you are asked to turn your back on your family, your parents and your community. That is not meant to be a hurtful thing to say, but Jesus did say you cannot love God and money. You must love one and hate the other. I marvel at the Little Sisters of the Poor as my example. In the world of sophisticated systems and processes, the Little Sisters still go out with their money boxes. They knock on doors and ask people to donate something to their charitable work. That is humility and dedication in action. The disciple of Jesus is called to focus. Our task is the work of God, to bring the Gospels to the world. That matters above all. We are not to be attached to anyone or anything else. Many times in the Gospels we are told that great crowds followed Jesus to hear Him. I

suspect that lots of them were just curious. He spoke in a very radical way. That is not attractive to those of us who



prefer to sit on the side. The day comes when you must pick a side. Which is it to be then?

Religious Education Registration Open for 2025-2026 Classes Begin This Week!

<u>Religious education registration</u> is open for the 2025-2026 school year. For grades 1-6, there are two options:

First Communion Registration

First Communion is a two-year program. Families who are going into their second year have already been contacted with registration information. If this will be your child's first year preparing for First Communion (grade 1 or higher), we will be doing registration in-person. We're going old school this year because we want to get to know families better and build parish community. If you have a child who needs to begin their first year of First Communion preparation, e-mail their baptism certificate and the date you completed the diocesan EIM/VIRTUS workshop to marti.salas@stcatherine-austin.org. If they were baptized here at St. Catherine's, let Marti know and she will look it up. After that, you will be sent a sign-up for a time to come in and register.

Post-First Communion Registration

Grades 7-12 Pre-Confirmation and Confirmation

Parents of students in grades 7-12 who are interested in Pre-Confirmation or Confirmation classes must schedule a meeting with Livia Telles-Rodriguez before registering (livia.telles-rodriguez@stcatherine-austin.org). Classes begin this Sunday, September 7.

Pre-Confirmation: Two years of pre-Confirmation classes are required before a student can attend Confirmation class. Pre-Confirmation classes can begin as early as grade 7. There are two options this year for pre-Confirmation: Sunday youth classes at St. Catherine of Siena twice a month **OR** at-home homework. Everyone must attend Sunday Mass twice a month and attend parish events.

Confirmation: Students in Confirmation class have completed two years of pre-Confirmation and are in grade 9 or above. Confirmation class will take place on Sundays in-person at St. Catherine of Siena for one semester. Everyone in Confirmation class must attend Sunday Mass twice a month and attend parish events.


