

Ordinary Time

As we spend a few weeks in Ordinary Time, until Ash Wednesday when the Lenten season begins, we'll look at some of the "ordinary" areas of our church. The reading stand on the altar is officially called the ambo. It is used for the liturgical readings, homilies and Prayer of the Faithful.

Upcoming February Feast Days




