

From the Pastor's Office

5th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jesus says in the gospel today, "You are the salt of the earth. You are the light of the world." The truth is, maybe, sometimes, occasionally, but not always. Jesus puts all these titles on me and maybe I don't deserve them. I am not particularly committed to my Christian life. I put money in the collection plate sometimes. I know I should do more, but I choose not to. Hear the advice of the prophet Isaiah today, "The Lord says, share your bread with the hungry, shelter the homeless, clothe the naked, do not turn your back on your own." Isaiah goes on, "Remove from your midst oppression,

false accusation, malicious speech. Bestow your bread on the hungry. Satisfy the afflicted." In order to be an authentic follower of God, and of my Christian life, I need to do these things. I don't do these things. I like it when someone else does it for me. I proclaim my faith, but I barely practice it. I have a beef with lots of you. You all tell me how much you are behind me. We need a new air conditioning system installed. People came to me and said, absolutely, we are right behind you. That is just talk. Most of you will offer not one dollar to help us out. Is my version of Christianity just all talk? If my Christianity is all talk, then what am I doing around here? What did Jesus say? If you are the cause of even one person to stray from God, it would be better if they tied a

millstone around your neck and throw you into the sea. Jesus asks me for a firm commitment to follow Him and live according to His commandments. He doesn't give me permission to water that down. I don't get to write an alternative version of the commandments to suit myself. That is what many people precisely do. They live a version of the Christian life, their own version. Let's stop doing that. Whoever said this so simply, thank you. "Mean what you say and say what you mean."



Liturgy

Ordinary Time

As we spend a few weeks in Ordinary Time, until Ash Wednesday when the Lenten season begins, we'll look at some of the "ordinary" areas of our church. Have you ever counted the sides on the Baptismal Font in St. Catherine's narthex? If so, you will know it has eight sides. And if you count the number of sides in St. Catherine's sanctuary, you will see that it mirrors the Baptismal Font, also with eight sides. So why eight? Seven is often considered a holy number, a number of perfection and completion – Creation taking seven days, the seven Sacraments, the seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit. So why use an octagon? The number eight is associated with Resurrection and new creation. Jesus rose on the "eighth day," the day after the Jewish Sabbath (Saturday). The Bible tells us eight people were saved on Noah's Ark. These connections to Baptism, water and the transforming power of the Sacraments remind us of our new life as Christians through Jesus.


