The Day Chapel and the Church are now closed until construction is complete, so we will not have Adoration during this time. We also will not have Liturgy of the Word with Children at 9:30 a.m. Sunday Mass until further notice.

Beginning August 1, the following will be temporarily eliminated until construction is complete:

- NO 5 p.m. Sunday Mass**
- NO Tuesday Confessions at 5:30 p.m.**
- NO Tuesday 7 p.m. Mass**
- NO Wednesday 12 p.m. Mass**

Mass will be livestreamed from Johnson Hall based on our normal schedule until August 17 (9:30 a.m. on Sundays; 12 p.m. on weekdays). **Beginning Monday, August 17, we will not be able to livestream daily 12 p.m. Mass, since Mass will be in Siena Hall while preschool is in session.** Sunday 9:30 a.m. Mass will continue to be livestreamed from Johnson Hall.

Finally, while Mass is celebrated in Johnson Hall, the Cafe will only serve coffee. No food will be permitted.

Thank you for your understanding while the Church undergoes construction for these necessary repairs.

Due to failure of the HVAC system in the Church, we will now have all Masses, Confessions and daily Rosaries in Johnson Hall of the Parish Center. **We will have our regularly scheduled weekend Masses as usual until August 1** (Saturdays at 5 p.m.; Sundays at 7:30 a.m., 9:30 a.m., 11:30 a.m., 1:15 p.m. and 5 p.m.). **We will have all daily Masses as usual until August 1** (12 p.m. Monday-Friday, with a 7 p.m. Mass on Tuesdays). The daily Rosary at 11:20 a.m. before weekday Masses will also be in Johnson Hall.

We will continue to have Confessions on Tuesday evenings from 5:30 p.m. - 6:45 p.m. and on Saturdays from 3:30 p.m. - 4:30 p.m. until August 1. Confessions will take place in room 131 of the Parish Center (go into the doors that lead to Johnson Hall, room 131 is straight ahead past the kitchen).

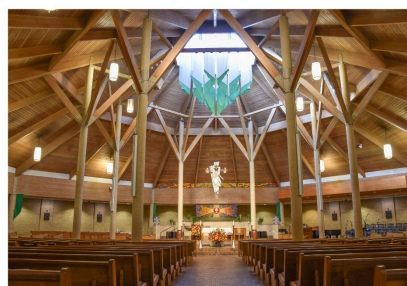
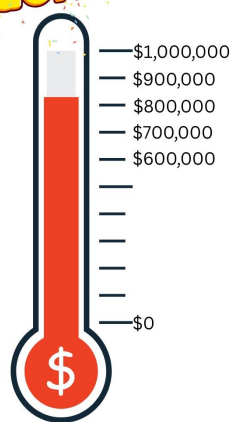

- Preparation and clearing procedures for different services.
- Removing and folding linens, washing or storing them properly.
- Safety and hygiene: ensuring linens are free from stains, tears, or contaminants before use.

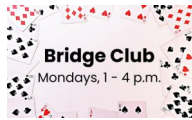

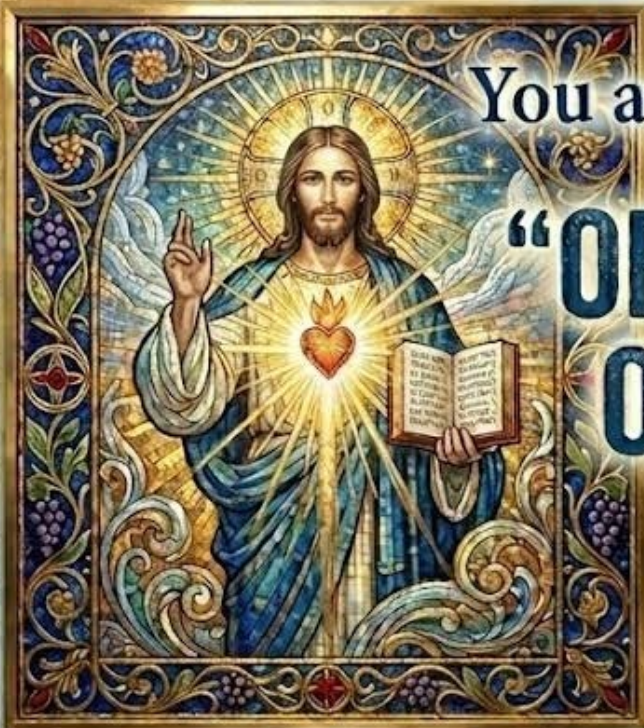
