Confessions are on Saturday from 3:30 p.m. - 4:30 p.m. and will take place in room 132 of the Parish Center (in the Johnson Hall area). The Day Chapel and the Church are closed until construction is complete, so we will not have Adoration during this time. We will not have Liturgy of the Word with Children at 9:30 a.m. Sunday Mass until further notice.

Mass will be livestreamed from Johnson Hall based on our normal schedule until August 17 (9:30 a.m. on Sundays; 12 p.m. on weekdays except Wednesdays). **Beginning Monday, August 17, we will not be able to livestream daily 12 p.m. Mass, since Mass will be in Siena Hall while preschool is in session.** Sunday 9:30 a.m. Mass will continue to be livestreamed from Johnson Hall.

Finally, while Mass is celebrated in Johnson Hall, the Cafe will only serve coffee. No food will be permitted.

Thank you for your understanding while the Church undergoes construction for these necessary repairs.

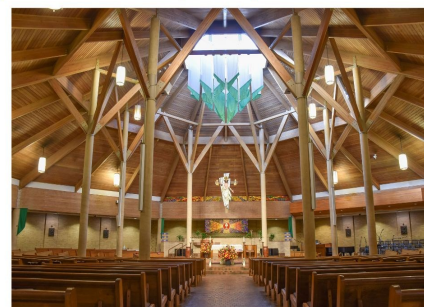

- Preparation and clearing procedures for different services.
- Removing and folding linens, washing or storing them properly.
- Safety and hygiene: ensuring linens are free from stains, tears, or contaminants before use.

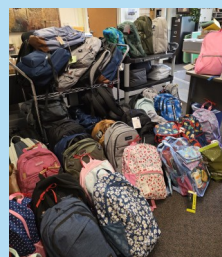

St. Catherine's Children's Faith Formation is now **Children's Evangelizing Catechesis**! What does this mean? Our focus this year will be on building community and helping children and families grow in a lifelong joyful and life-giving faith:

- Our weekly in-person program will begin with a large group gathering in the hall where we pray and celebrate together as a community before moving to individual, grade-level classrooms.
- Families will be encouraged to join us for Sunday Mass; however, the Liturgical Seek & Find will not be part of our program this year.
- Our Family Faith program will still afford families the opportunity to take the lead on their children's catechesis at home on their schedule while attending and participating in parish events to develop a deeper connection to our parish community.

"Evangelizing catechesis seeks to deepen a personal encounter with Jesus Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit" (Handbook on the Catechetical Accompaniment Process). In this process, the Church first seeks out and welcomes us when we are moved by the Gospel and then accompanies us, assisting us in the lifelong process of becoming great disciples.

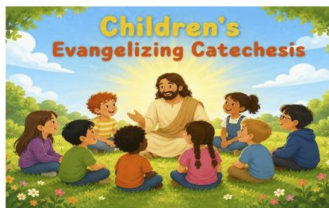

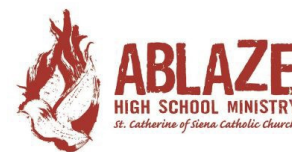

Faith Formation for Children & Youth Registration 2026 - 2027



Faith formation registration for children and youth at St. Catherine of Siena Catholic Church is now open for the 2026-2027 school year! This year, we are offering the following programs:

- Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (Kindergarten)
- Children's Evangelizing Catechesis (Grades 1-6, including First Reconciliation/First Communion)
- Ignite (Grades 7-8 Pre-Confirmation)
- Ablaze (Grades 9-11 Pre-Confirmation)
- Confirmation (Grades 9-12 with two years of Pre-Confirmation completed)
- Becoming Catholic: The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA) Adapted for Children and Youth

More information about each program is detailed below. In order to enroll children into any of our programs, the following must be complete:

1. Families must be [registered parishioners](#) at St. Catherine of Siena Catholic Church.
2. At least one parent **must** complete the [Ethics in Ministry \(EIM\)](#) program through the Diocese of Austin. This parent will be required to help out in the classroom at times during the year. EIM certification is good for three years.
3. Copies of your children's baptism certificates need to be turned in to the Faith Formation office if your child is preparing for a sacrament and we do not already have one on file. Catechesis of the Good Shepherd - Kindergarten Faith Formation

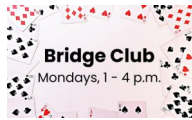

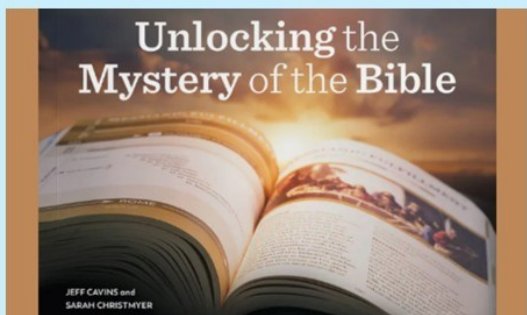

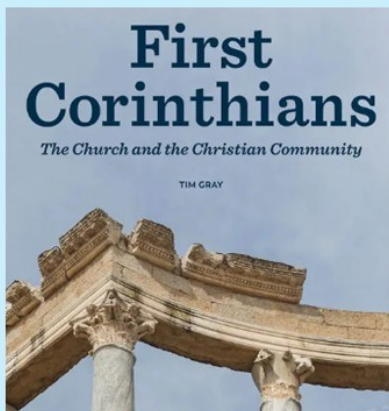
