Getting Back On Track

Mass

- Students in ALL grades will be attending the Thursday school Mass.
- School Masses will be open to parents and the public.

Getting Back On Track (cont.)

Morning Car Line

- 7:15 a.m. – 8:00 a.m.
- Through the side entrance to the gym
- Students can be dropped off through the line beginning at 7:15. Drop off through the car line is encouraged.
- Parents will be allowed to exit their cars to walk students up from 7:50 am - 8:00 am but must park in a marked parking space and may not cross through the drop off line. Parking is available in the front parking lot facing Harrison St. Parents may enter the elementary building through the east entrance (nearest the office).
- Parents will enter off of Marable Street at the south entrance and form a line to the gym. The exit will be the drive closest to the church on Harrison St. See attached graphic for details

Dismissal Car Line

- The bell rings at 3:30 and students will make their way to the gym at that time. Loading will begin shortly after.
- All car dismissal will be conducted through the side door of the Gym. Loading will be done 3 cars at a time
- Parents will enter off of Marable Street at the south entrance and form a line to the gym. The exit will be the drive closest to the church on Harrison St. See attached graphic for details
- Parents may walk up to pick up their child. They may walk up to the gym entrance inside the parish center and wait for the staff member on duty to call your child(ren). Once children have been picked up, parents must exit the building.

Cleaning & Disinfecting

- Surfaces will continue to be disinfected throughout the day using approved disinfectant.
- Electronic devices will continue to be cleaned throughout the day using disinfecting wipes.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided in all classrooms and common areas.

Lunch/Snacks

- All students will be eating lunch in the cafeteria or outside (if weather permits).
- Tables will be sanitized before eating.
- At this time, visitors may join students for lunch. If this policy needs to be adjusted due to COVID cases at school, we will inform you via email.
- Students will bring water bottles and utilize the bottle filling stations located throughout campus.

Daily Screenings

- Parents will self-screen their child(ren) before coming on campus. Teachers and Staff will self-screen before coming on campus. Student/Teacher/Staff presence on campus is an admission that screening has been completed and it has been determined “safe” for that individual to be in school. See self-screening form attached.

Distance Learning

- Distance Learning will only be provided in cases where students are subject to a documented COVID quarantine. Distance learning is not offered as a choice for families at this time.
