

Sunday Reflection

How many of us can say that I've done what God asked of me. I've fulfilled my task. "Your will is done".... I would surmise that most of us would say not yet. Some may say, I'm too busy for that. Or I don't even know what is ahead of me so how do I know what my calling is?

This year, we will spend time to hear the Gospel written by St Luke. Interestingly, he began in Jesus' home town, in Nazareth. And Jesus' first act was to read the scroll of Isaiah. Jesus chose chapter 42, saying that He is sent to bring "liberty to captives... sight to the blind... the oppressed go free."

And, instead of a drawn-out sermon to show His knowledge, his understanding. Jesus gave one of His shortest homilies recorded. Consisting of only 9 English words. 'Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing'.

These 9 simple words shocked the community. How is it that the "son of a carpenter" was able to say that the prophesy of Isaiah be fulfilled by this Jesus? How can this young man of 30 be God's anointed? They could not believe, they could not comprehend, they could not accept.

With hindsight, we know this to be true. That Jesus completed His task, to bring salvation to all of us. Now, wouldn't it be good if God really talks to us like He does with Jesus? Tell us what He wants so that we know what to do?

The thing is, God speaks to of each us differently. He speaks to us through Scriptures; sometimes through the urging of the Spirit; sometimes through words, signs and messages around us. The problem is: are we listening? Are we opening our hearts and spirit to the nudging of God? Do we recognize our roles as part of His Church; to do the will of God? Do we answer the call of the Spirit; fulfill the call that our baptism and confirmation has prepared for us. Do we allow the gifts of the Holy Spirit to bring us to action? Do we help build Christ' church here at home, at St. Justin? So, when we are asked, we can stand upright and say, yes, I did the will of God. Your task for me has been fulfilled.
