THE PASTOR'S PEN

Greetings in Christ Jesus!

The real presence of Christ in the Eucharist is a doctrine, an official teaching of the Catholic Church and a profound mystery. With the words of consecration, the whole of Christ is truly present under the appearances of bread and wine.

The doctrine is based upon the words of Jesus Himself when He instituted the Eucharist. Jesus took the bread and said, "This is my body", and He took the cup filled with wine and said, "This is my blood".

We accept and believe what Jesus said as a matter of faith. We take Jesus at His word because He is truth, He came into the world to testify to the truth, and the words that He spoke are spirit and life.

St. Cyril of Alexandria wrote, "Do not doubt whether this is true, but rather receive the words of the Savior in faith, for since He is truth, He cannot lie." The words of Jesus are clear and unambiguous.

Over the centuries, some non-believers have attacked the Catholic belief in the Real Presence with claims that it is impossible, ridiculous or superstition. In the face of questions, misunderstanding and attack, the Church has defined, defended and reinforced its teaching on the Real Presence.

The doctrine was enunciated by the Fourth Lateran Council in 1215 and reaffirmed and rearticulated by the Council of Constance in 1415.

During the upheaval of the Protestant Reformation, the Council of Trent declared in 1551, "By the consecration of the bread and wine there takes place a change of the whole substance of the bread into the substance of the Body of Christ our Lord."

Those who believe no proof is needed.

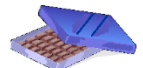
