THE PASTOR'S PEN

Greetings in Christ Jesus!

As we continue our journey through this Lenten season, this Sunday's gospel reading offers us the account of Our Lord meeting with the Samaritan woman at the well. The question for us today is: For what do we thirst?

If we read carefully the opening lines of our Gospel reading, we will see that text points ahead to another event in the Gospel. Our Lord is tired and sits down by a well. We are told it was 'about the sixth hour'.

The well of Sychar prefigures the cruciform-well of the Cross of Our Lord, on which he made reparation for all humanity 'at the sixth hour'. The Cross becomes the sacred well of living water which satisfies the thirst of every man and woman.

St Augustine tells us that Our Lord represents Israel, and the Samaritan woman the Gentile people. The well of Sychar is a meeting point. Here is the meeting of the Son of God Jesus and the woman of Samaria.

At Calvary, the cosmic well, we have the meeting of the divided creation with its Creator. We have the outpouring of the life-giving water of grace for broken humanity, symbolized in the water that came from Jesus' pierced side.

Christ is always ready to impart to us his life-giving grace in order that we may enjoy relationship with him. First, we must recognize our thirst; only then we can seek to quench it by means of the Cross.

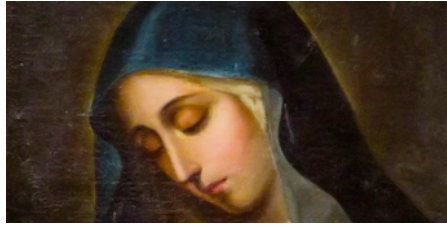

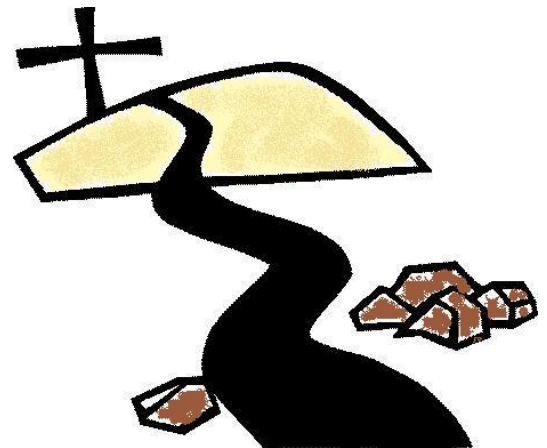

Julianne Stanz – Eucharistic Revival and Missionary Disciples Workshop for Parish Eucharistic Revival Teams

Julianne Stanz, a member of the Executive Team for the National Eucharistic Revival, will be presenting a retreat for Eucharistic Revival parish teams on either Saturday, April 22nd (at St. Bernard's in Thief River Falls 10:00 am to 3:30 pm) or Sunday, April 23rd (at Holy Rosary in Detroit Lakes, 12:30 am to 4:30 pm). Julianne is the Director of Discipleship and Parish Life for the Diocese of Green Bay and serves as a consultant to the Catechesis and Evangelization Committee for the USCCB.

During this 4.5 hour retreat, Julianne will guide participants into the heart of the revival as parish teams seek to develop the Eucharistic Revival - Parish Year (2023-2024) while also considering the role of the third year for the Revival: The Mission Year (2024-2025).
