## THE PASTOR'S PEN

Greetings in Christ Jesus!

The theme of this Sunday is resurrection and the life. The three readings of today fit beautifully together as they tell us of death yielding to a new way of life. The Gospel tells us that Jesus is the Resurrection and life.

We have the story of the raising of Lazarus from the dead to bring him back to life symbolizing that Jesus himself is the resurrection and life. This miracle leads us to believe in resurrection and new life which exists in Jesus through the Holy Spirit.

With this miracle the church invites us to reflect on the significance of our Baptism which leads us into the life of the Holy Spirit. The gift of the Spirit we received at Baptism is a transforming gift.

The spirit of Christ will strengthen us to bring those baptized together to share in the resurrection of Jesus. The Gospel story of the raising of Lazarus from death has the underlying theme of life and death and new life.

In the entire episode, Jesus is the central figure, who challenged each participant by clarifying the central issue: the real meaning of death and life. In Bethany Jesus works this miracle and reunites Lazarus with his family.

The raising of Lazarus is not just the resuscitation of a dead man but is a powerful symbol of the new life that all of us can undergo when we submit to Jesus as Lord and Savior. Through our Baptism we all die to sin to receive a new life.

To be raised from the dead, to be fully alive, means to be in a living, loving relationship with Jesus, who teaches us that resurrection and life are a call to be united with him.
