THE PASTOR'S PEN

Greetings in Christ Jesus!

Most of us get irritated and give way to anger over all kinds of issues and so we imagine God must be like this too. The Bible apparently agrees. God can sometimes be angry.

But there is a great difference between human anger and divine anger. Human anger is often the result of feeling frustrated or impotent and it is directed at those whom we decide to blame, at other human beings, or perhaps at God himself.



But divine anger is altogether different. God is never frustrated. Moreover, he never please talk to the RE Coordinators or wavers in his infinite love and mercy. So, God's anger is just another dimension of his love for us.
