From the Desk of Father Raaser

It was to be an antidote to the secularism, atheism, socialism and communism of the day. Pope Pius XI on December 11, 1925 in an encyclical entitled, *Quas Primas* established the feast of Christ the King. It originally was assigned to the last Sunday of October, closest to the Solemnity of All Saints Day. In the reform of the Liturgical calendar in 1969, the feast was transferred to the last Sunday of the Church's year.

"King" was one of the earliest titles given to the Lord. The Lord is called king throughout the gospels and the New Testament. The title does not refer to a status of an earthly king, which many of the Jews had been expecting – someone to overthrow the Roman rule and be earthly king of Israel. Rather the Lord came to be the spiritual king; His kingdom is in heaven, it begins here and now and is not completely realized and fulfilled until the end of this world; we get glimpses of the Kingdom among us.

At the end of another Church's year, it is a good time for us to reflect on how we did this past year of grace. Are we closer in following the way of Christian life, or are we falling away? Did we grow closer to the Lord in our prayer life and Christian living?

There is a custom to pray at the end of the year a hymn of praise called the **Te Deum**. Its authorship is traditionally ascribed to Saints Ambrose and Augustine, on the occasion of Augustine's baptism in 387AD.

The hymn remains in regular use in the Office of Readings found in the Liturgy of the Hours, and for special grand occasions such as the canonization of a new saint. It is a beautiful prayer. Pray it and thank God for all the many graces that you and your family received this past year of grace.

We praise you, O God: we acknowledge you as Lord. All the earth venerates you as the eternal Father.

To you all the angels, to you the heavens and all the powers: to you the cherubim and seraphim sing with unending voice: "Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord God of hosts. Heaven and earth are full of the majesty of your glory."

The glorious chorus of Apostles praises you, the praiseworthy number of prophets praises you, the white-robed army of martyrs praises you. The holy Church gives witness to you throughout the whole world as the Father of immense majesty; your true and only Son who is to be worshipped, and also the Holy Spirit, the Paraclete. O Christ, you are the king of glory. You are the eternal son of the Father. Undertaking to liberate humanity, you did not dread the womb of the Virgin. By overcoming the sting of death, you opened the kingdom of heaven to believers. You sit at the right hand of God, in the glory of the Father.

We believe you will come as judge. Therefore we ask you, assist your servants, whom you have redeemed by your precious blood. Make them to be numbered among the holy ones in eternal glory.

Save your people, Lord, and bless your inheritance. And rule them, and lift them up into eternity. We bless you every day; and we praise your name for ever, and throughout all ages.

Deign to keep us, O Lord, without sin this day. Have mercy on us, O Lord, have mercy on us. May your mercy be upon us, O Lord, since we have hoped in you. I have hoped in you, O Lord: may I not be confounded forever. Amen

Next Sunday we begin a new year of Grace 2018 with the First Sunday of Advent.
