## From the Desk of Father Raaser

In early June, two more celebrities committed suicide. They were rich and famous; qualities the world says are significant and worthy of much sacrifice to attain. Why are they killing themselves?

We as a society enjoy social, technological, and economic advances that far surpass any other generation. We enjoy better health, longer life spans, less air pollution, higher levels of education, higher per-capita income, and greater personal and civil liberties than at any other time in history. All these material gains should add up to an increased sense of happiness and well-being. But they don't. Depression has increased over 1,000% since the 1950's.

Suicide has become the tenth most leading cause of death in the U.S., the second leading cause of death among individuals between the ages of 10 and 34, and the fourth leading cause of death among individuals between the ages of 35 and 54. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention 2016 Report saw almost 19,000 homicides in the United States; the number of suicides was more than twice that at 45,000.

64,000 lives lost to violence, not to mention the reported 800,000 legal abortions performed that same year. We human beings, loved into existence and created in the image and likeness of God, are throwing ourselves away. Why are we missing the most fundamental aspect of who we are? Why do we think so little of ourselves?

G.K. Chesterton, the Catholic apologist wrote, "The man who kills himself, kills all men; as far as he is concerned he wipes out the world." Why do people want to kill the world in which they live?

For many, they have no meaning in their life. Nothing makes sense to them; all their hopes and dreams were dashed through the years, all the empty promises given to them as youth go unfulfilled. We tell our young people they can do and be anything they want to be, a great lie. Thinking all things are within their grasp, simply by hard work and that they can attain their self-actualization, another lie.

It is when we replace God and place our hopes on technology, pleasure, sensuality, desire, even humanity that we find ourselves in the Garden of Eden again. What should be paradise becomes a place of sin, nakedness and shame. We create a world without God, and it becomes hell: cold, lifeless and without purpose or hope. We see ourselves not as spirit and flesh, but just as a genetic machine. It becomes so intolerable that people want to destroy that world, so they kill themselves.

There is a general pessimism, emptiness to life, which is expressed in our movies, art and TV shows. So, no wonder people want to kill the world. People are so full of self-loathing and self-deception that the idea of anyone else loving them, particularly God, seems unimaginable. This is a terrible lie, of course. When the feeling becomes so a part of them, the battle against it can be lifelong. It is usually in the weakest of moments — moments that we know will pass but they cannot see how — that the fight is lost. They throw themselves away. The people left behind then agonize over why their loved-one did not believe in love, call on love, depend on love, and trust love. God is Love.

It is only God who gives meaning to our life; it is only following Christ, who is the Way, Truth, and Life that helps us when dark moments enter our life.

We of course can never judge the state of someone's soul. We must pray for those who find life unlivable and pray even harder for the loved ones left behind. Peace happens when people pray.

Love the people in your life, love them and let them know it, so they don't kill the world.

#### Saint Aloysius Gonzaga **Patron Saint of Youth**

Do your parents have plans for you? As soon as Aloysius was born, his parents began planning for his future. His mother wanted him to be a priest. His father was determined to have his oldest son become a military leader or famous political figure—anything but a priest.

While he was on a visit to Spain with his parents, Aloysius read the lives of saintly Jesuit missionaries, and he decided to become a Jesuit. His father and some other relatives tried to change his mind. It was a fierce battle of wills, but after several years, Aloysius won. With his father's permission, Aloysius gave his large inheritance to his brother and joined the Jesuit order at 17 years of age.

When Aloysius was 23, a serious epidemic broke out in Rome. Aloysius volunteered at once to help in the hospital. At that time hospitals were not the clean, orderly places they are today. Aloysius became very ill and no medicine could help him. Aloysius was not afraid to die.

Aloysius shows that young people are not too young to become saints. During his life he had focused on doing what God wanted-serving and loving God and his neighbor.
