From the Desk of Father Raaser

On August 6th and 9th, 1945, 73 years ago, atomic bombs were dropped on the Japanese cities of Hiroshima and Nagasaki, thus ending WWII. Both cities were greatly populated by Catholics. On August 9th the bomb named "Fat Man" was dropped from a B-29 into the heavily populated city of Nagasaki. The epicenter of the blast was the Urakami district, the heart and soul of Catholicism in Japan since the sixteenth century. The Nagasaki atomic bomb was considerably more powerful than the one dropped three days earlier on Hiroshima, where 140,000 of the city's 255,000 inhabitants were quickly killed. Of the 12,000 Catholics in the Urakami district, 8,500 were killed.

Nagasaki has a wonderful Catholic history. Nagasaki was first evangelized in 1549 by Jesuit missionaries from Portugal, led by the Spanish Jesuit St. Francis Xavier, who arrived in Nagasaki on August 15, the feast day of the Assumption of Mary. As we will see August 15th is an important date. By the way, Japan surrendered on August 15, 1949!

Spared from the Nagasaki blast was the famous Catholic mission church founded by a young Franciscan priest-evangelist who came to Nagasaki and started a magazine to help evangelize the people. The magazine *The Knight* became the largest Catholic publication in Japan, with a circulation in 1933 of 50,000. The Church was built in the 1930s, on the foothills facing away from the future blast. The young priest called the friary the "Garden of the Immaculate."

The young priest left Japan in 1936, to establish a "City of the Immaculate" in his native Poland. Unfortunately, the Nazis fiercely dismantled the Polish "City of the Immaculate." The priest was arrested along with many other priests, religious and many other Catholics. Ultimately the priest would be martyred at Auschwitz on August 14. His body would be placed in one of the ovens, on Aug. 15th. His name of course is St. Maximillian Kolbe. A living saint ties Nagasaki and Auschwitz, places of death and destruction together. St. Kolbe died 4 years before his beloved city of Nagasaki was bombed. In both cases, out of death comes life. Nagasaki became after the war, the center of Catholic evangelization for all of Asia.

Tomorrow is the 73rd anniversary of death and nuclear destruction. Next Tuesday is the 77th anniversary of St. Maximillian Kolbe's birth to eternal life as a martyr. These days are the prelude to the Solemnity of the Assumption, next Wednesday.

One last interesting fact: four Jesuit priests, stationed in Hiroshima at the Church of Our Lady of the Assumption, which was only blocks from the epicenter of the Hiroshima explosion, were spared when virtually everyone around them was killed. They were praying the rosary after Mass. It was 8:15AM, the exact time the bomb was dropped! Our Lady watches over and protects her children.

MASS CARDS The giving of a "Mass Card" to an individual or a family is a traditional and honored custom of the Catholic Community. Mass Cards can be given or sent for:-the repose of the soul of a deceased person or -for a Special Intention:

-Special Intention Cards are for a living person and are obtained for a number of reasons: general good wishes, birthdays, anniversaries, return to good health, in thanksgiving, or for a particular need or moment in the life of another, e.g. a new home.

There are two types of Mass Cards:

-An "**Announced Mass**" means that the Mass will be celebrated on a certain day at a scheduled Mass time when the priest announces the intention to the congregation and it is printed in the weekly parish bulletin.

-An "**Unannounced Mass**" refers to a Mass when the intention is remembered by one of the priests at a Mass that has no announced intention.

Mass cards may be obtained at the Parish Center during regular office hours – (9 AM – 4:30 PM, Mon. - Fri.).

The donation for an Announced Mass is \$ 15;
\$ 10 for an Unannounced Mass
