From the Desk of Father Raaser

Continuing with our Church etiquette, we leave the plain of the Earth and climb up to the Door (Christ) and enter through Him. We bless ourselves with Holy Water to remind us of whom we belong through Baptism. We find our favorite place to sit, but before we enter the pew, we have to acknowledge whose House this is, who is our Host for the next hour.

Our act of reverence is called a genuflection (Medieval Latin genüflectere to bend the knee, Latin genü = knee + flectere = to bend).

Historically speaking, the act of genuflecting on one knee comes from court etiquette and was done while in the presence of a medieval king or noble. It was a sign of respect as well as a pledge of service.

Christians adopted this custom over time, and it became fully integrated into the Church by the 16th century. The left knee was always used to give reverence to a king so Christians would genuflect in church on the right knee to God.

Jews and Christians have always known God as a king; Christians thought it fitting to pay respect and honor to Him by genuflecting every time they entered His "court." This meant bending on one knee whenever they passed in front of the tabernacle — the "tent" that holds the Blessed Sacrament.

For Catholics we believe that Jesus is truly present, Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity in the Holy Eucharist and so when we genuflect, we do so because we are in God's presence. If we can't genuflect because of age or bad knees, or the fear of not being able to get back up (I'm reaching that age myself!), then a bow to the Lord suffices. In faith, we need to make an acknowledgement of where we are.

Where do you sit? Select a location which will give you the best opportunity for participation in the Mass. Usually the front half of the church is your best place for seeing, hearing and participating.

After entering the pew, kneel for a few minutes of prayer before sitting down. This is a valuable time for private prayer in the Lord's house. Say your morning or evening prayers; on the back cover of the missalette are some prayers to be offered.

Then it is time to prepare for the liturgy. Read the opening prayer, the "Collect." The Collect is the gathering of all our individual prayers, and as one offering of prayer to God, the priest, on behalf of all the people offers the opening prayer to God our Father. The collect usually sets the theme of the Mass and readings.

The Mass is one continuous prayer to God, usually using the words found in Sacred Scripture. The Mass is not entertainment, where you passively sit and watch. You are not an audience, looking on. You are called to be active participants primarily interiorly through prayer, then through your voice and actions.

Be active at Mass.
