- Conscience a judgment that something is right or wrong based on God's laws
- Contrition sorrow for the sin committed and resolution not to sin again
- Corporal Works of Mercy acts of charity towards the bodily needs of our neighbor
- Covenant a contract or agreement made between two persons
- Holiness all Christian are called to be "perfect" in Christ
- New Testament 27 books of the Bible written about the life and teachings of Jesus
- Old Testament 46 books of the Bible about the history of salvation from creation to the covenant with Israel
- Saint –holy person who loved God & is now with Him in heaven, we are all called to be saints
- Sanctus is a prayer spoken aloud at Mass which proclaims the coming of the Lord
- Spiritual Works of Mercy acts of charity towards the spiritual needs of our neighbor
- Temptation an attraction to act against the commandments of God
