If you're looking for some good reading in the long, lazy days of summer, I have a few suggestions you may like.

My first recommendation is a book written by Robert Cardinal Sarah, who is head of the Congregation for Divine Worship and a brilliant theologian. He also happens to be one of my favorite bishops because of his absolute commitment to proclaiming the truth. He has recently published a book entitled, "***The Power of Silence***." That title is perfect, for in it he demonstrates the necessity of silence in our lives if we expect to have a deeper relationship with the Lord, especially in such a noisy world as this one. Cell phones, text messages, music (usually bad music) blasting in our ears constantly; these are just some of the examples of the noise that we have become so accustomed to but are damaging to our spiritual life—and in many ways our family life. And he offers practical and understandable solutions to these current day issues of "noise pollution"

But it's about more than that. He also talks about "silent active participation" at Holy Mass, which is just as efficacious as vocal active participation.

Though it's written in a question and answer format, it's not an easy read, and it can be dense at times—Cardinal Sarah is a very erudite man. He also deals with "God's silence in times of Evil." This is not easily explained, as evil itself is a great mystery, but this book is well worth the effort if you have the time. I believe you will find it spiritually and intellectually challenging and rewarding.

Another suggestion for anyone who wants to do more devotional reading this summer is a book entitled, "***Living the Mystery of Merciful Love: 30 Days with Therese of Lisieux***." It explores the many letters of Therese written to various people (including her sisters, who were nuns) on so many topics relevant to today's problems, even though they were written over a century ago. Anthony Lilles and Dan Burke provide excellent commentary and application to daily life. This is a book I highly recommend.

Finally, for our teens and young adults, I suggest "***Pure Faith: A Prayer Book For Teens***" by Jason Evert. This is, in my opinion, the best prayer book ever written for modern-day teenagers. Not only does it provide all of the traditional prayers of our faith (with nice artwork), not only does it illustrate the lives of our greatest saints in a way that is interesting and new, but it does the most important thing of all: it teaches our Catholic Faith, even some of the more difficult teachings, in a simple and profound way. It is NOT a watered-down, dumbed down version of the doctrines, but a sweet and inviting way for our young people, at such a critical period in their lives, to see the beauty and richness of our Sacraments. Very few authors do that as well as Jason Evert, and when I was in a parish that had a Catholic school, this was always the graduation gift I would give them.

Anyway, have fun on the beach, or in your backyard pool or wherever you may find yourself this summer. You certainly deserve a break!

And if you have the time, please consider reading or at least browsing through these book recommendations.

You won't regret it.
