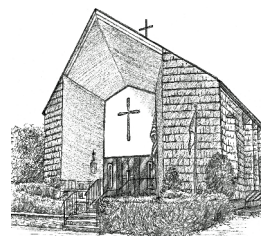

Eligibility to be a Godparent/Sponsor for either Baptism or Confirmation.

1. A baptized Catholic, have been Confirmed and received First Holy Communion,
2. 14 years of age or older (Archdiocese of N Y only),
3. Attend to Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation,
4. Attend to Catholic duty by participating in the Sacrament of Reconciliation and receive the Eucharist at least once a year during the Easter season,
5. In a recognized Catholic marriage, that is, married in the Catholic Church, or received proper canonical dispensation to enter marriage with a non-Catholic,
6. If single, not co-habiting with a person who is not a spouse,
7. Registered member of a parish church,
8. Not a parent to the candidate who will receive the sacrament., Not bound by any canonical penalty legitimately imposed or declared, and
9. Fully understand and accept the obligations of a godparent/sponsor, to lead a life of faith and to pray for and to assist my Godchild/Sponsored candidate in his/her spiritual growth.

WEEK 4, evening lighting prayer

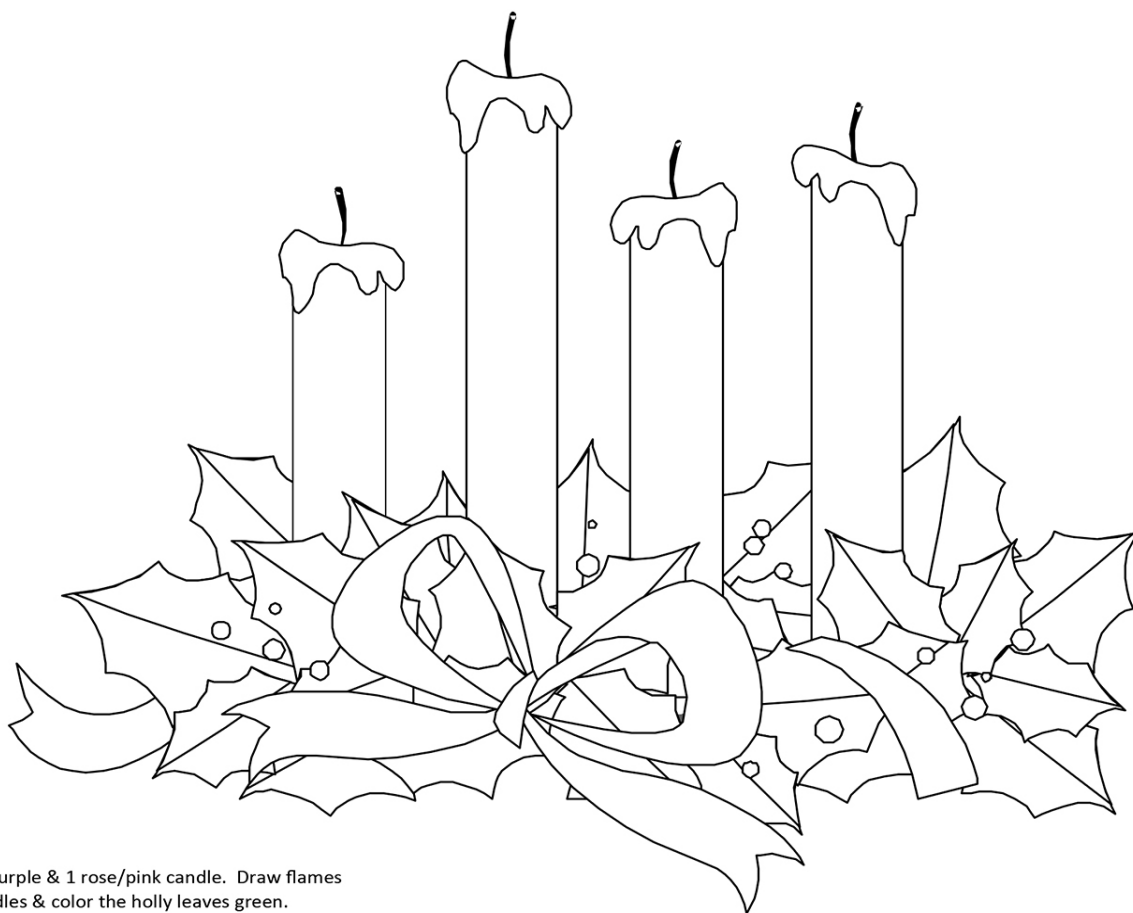
Prayer said by Father or head of household
