Caster Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord First Reading: Acts 10:34a, 37-43

Peter discusses Jesus' life of preaching and healing. Jesus was crucified, and then he rose up and was seen by his chosen witnesses. Peter also mentions the importance of all the disciples bearing witness to what they saw, so that many people would believe in Jesus, and have their sins forgiven through him.

Second Reading: Colossians 3:1-4

Paul asserts that we must pay attention to higher realms rather than earthly concerns. Our life is not yet completely known to us, until Christ appears and we are raised to glory in him.

Gospel: John 20:1-9

When Mary Magdalene discovered Jesus' tomb was open, she told Simon Peter and another disciple. They ran to the tomb and Peter went inside. He found the burial wrappings on the ground, with the head covering separate from the rest. The other disciple came in and they believed what they saw, although until then they had not understood the Scripture's message of Jesus' resurrection.

Evangelio: San Juan 20:1-9

Cuando María Magdalena descubrió que la tumba de Jesús estaba abierta, le dijo a Simón Pedro y al otro discípulo. Ellos corrieron a la tumba y Pedro entró. Encontró las vendas en el suelo, con la tela para envolver la cabeza aparte. El otro discípulo entró y ambos creyeron lo que veían, pues todavía no habían entendido lo que dice la Escritura, que El tenía que resucitar.



NEW YORK ASSISTED SUICIDE LEGISLATION: ADVOCACY DAY

Once the New York state assembly finalizes the budget, likely this month, lawmakers will shift towards other issues such as assisted suicide. The New York Alliance Against Assisted Suicide expects that the annual campaign to pass this dangerous legislation will be especially strong this year. On May 6th, the NYAAAS Say No to Assisted Suicide Advocacy Day will be an opportunity to demonstrate opposition to this bill and advocate for those who it places at risk. The day will include a brief training session about assisted suicide and a large grassroots demonstration at the New York State Capitol in Albany.
