



Fourth Sunday of Easter

First Reading: Acts 13:14, 43-52

Paul and Barnabas addressed many people, and large crowds gathered to hear them. Some of the Jews became jealous, and argued with whatever Paul said. But Paul and Barnabas continued preaching their message of salvation and everlasting life, until they were eventually forced to leave the town.

Second Reading: Revelation 7:9, 14b-17

John saw a vision of many people surrounding a throne and the Lamb. One of the elders told him these were the people who had survived great periods of trial, but maintained strong faith in God. Now they would receive eternal protection and comfort from God as reward for their loyalty.

Gospel: John 10:27-30

Jesus states that his sheep know his voice and follow him, and will receive eternal life. Jesus also says that no one can snatch his followers away, because God is greater than anyone who might try, and Jesus is one with God.

2025 FOOD SUBSIDY PROGRAM FOR PAWLING FARMERS MARKET

The Pawling Farmers Market (PFM) will be operating a farmers market on the Village Green in Pawling every Saturday from June 14-September 27. You can purchase fresh fruit, vegetables, eggs, meat, cheese, bread, pickles, coffee, cookies and pastries, jams and jellies, honey, maple syrup, prepared food and so much more, while supporting local and small businesses and enjoying live music on the Green. Because it can be difficult for many in our community to afford fresh food, PFM has a program that provides cash-equivalent tokens each week to qualified customers to use at the market to purchase fresh produce and food products. In 2025, PFM will be offering weekly tokens worth at least \$15 and perhaps more, depending upon funding, through this FeedYour Neighbor (FYN) program. Those who live, work or worship in Pawling or Holmes/Whaley Lake and have income below a certain level qualify. To participate in the FeedYour Neighbor program, please go to the Pawling Resource Center to complete an application. Applicants will need to provide proof of residence, work or worship in Pawling and make a statement regarding income. If you have questions about the program, please call Chris Carty (917-670-7340). 



• Speaker Reverend Father Robert Carolan

Father Carolan was born in Ridgewood, N.J. and raised in Yorktown Heights, Westchester County, N.Y. He attended St. Elizabeth Ann Seton School and Yorktown High School. He earned a bachelor's degree in applied sociology from East Carolina University in North Carolina and a master's in physical education in sports pedagogy from Manhattanville College in Purchase. After teaching in Catholic schools for a few years, he entered St. Joseph's Seminary where he earned a bachelor's degree in sacred theology, a master's of divinity, and a master's in dogmatic theology. Ordained a priest by Cardinal Dolan on May 29, 202 I, he was assigned as a Parochial Vicar at Annunciation — Our Lady of Fatima Church in Westchester County before his current assignment to St. James The Apostle and Our Lady of the Lake Mount Carmel Church in Carmel, NY.






