## Fifth Sunday of Easter

### First Reading: Acts 14:21-27

## Marian Hymn for the Easter Season: The Regina Coeli



During the year, a Marian chant/hymn is offered here frequently as the final procession after Sunday Mass. There is an ancient, beautiful precedent for this in the liturgical worship of the Catholic Church. It symbolizes that the Blessed Virgin Mary is truly a mother to us, praying for us and encouraging us at all times as we return back into the world filled with both the word of God spoken to us in the Sacred Scripture in the Liturgy of the Word, and the Word of God consumed by us in the Liturgy of the Eucharist. The Blessed Mother not only carried our Lord during His development for nine months, but throughout her entire life, the Blessed Virgin Mary carried Jesus in her heart and soul wherever Our Lady went. We too should live our lives with that same attitude. Who better to give the world Jesus than His greatest disciple, Mother Mary? So too, we as disciples are called to proclaim Jesus wherever we go, whatever we do, and whomever we encounter. And when necessary, even use words!

During the Season of Easter, the favored chant/hymn prayer is the Regina Coeli or Queen of Heaven, Rejoice!

Please go to our website and click on the version of this beautiful chant. Listening to it repeatedly will help you familiarize yourself with it. The closing prayer in parentheses is usually never sung. — *Fr. JP*

## 2025 FOOD SUBSIDY PROGRAM FOR PAWLING FARMERS MARKET

The Pawling Farmers Market (PFM) will be operating a farmers market on the Village Green in Pawling every Saturday from June 14-September 27. You can purchase fresh fruit, vegetables, eggs, meat, cheese, bread, pickles, coffee, cookies and pastries, jams and jellies, honey, maple syrup, prepared food and so much more, while supporting local and small businesses and enjoying live music on the Green. Because it can be difficult for many in our community to afford fresh food, PFM has a program that provides cash-equivalent tokens each week to qualified customers to use at the market to purchase fresh produce and food products. In 2025, PFM will be offering weekly tokens worth at least \$15 and perhaps more, depending upon funding, through this Feed Your Neighbor (FYN) program. Those who live, work or worship in Pawling or Holmes/Whaley Lake and have income below a certain level qualify. To participate in the Feed Your Neighbor program, please go to the Pawling Resource Center to complete an application. Applicants will need to provide proof of residence, work or worship in Pawling and make a statement regarding income. If you have questions about the program, please call Chris Carty (917-670-7340).

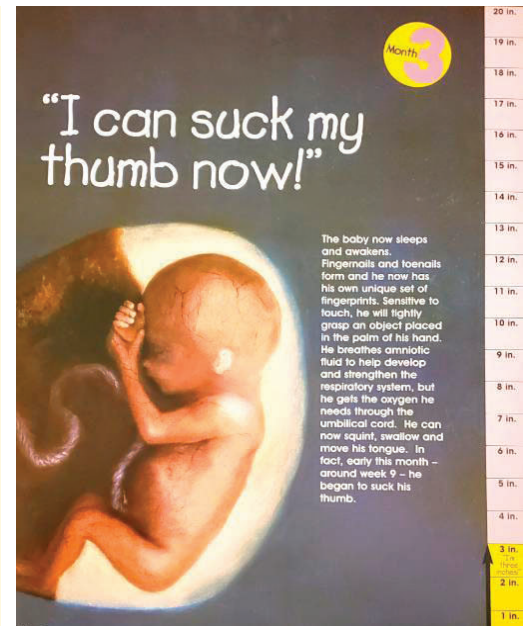
### DEFUND PLANNED PARENTHOOD
