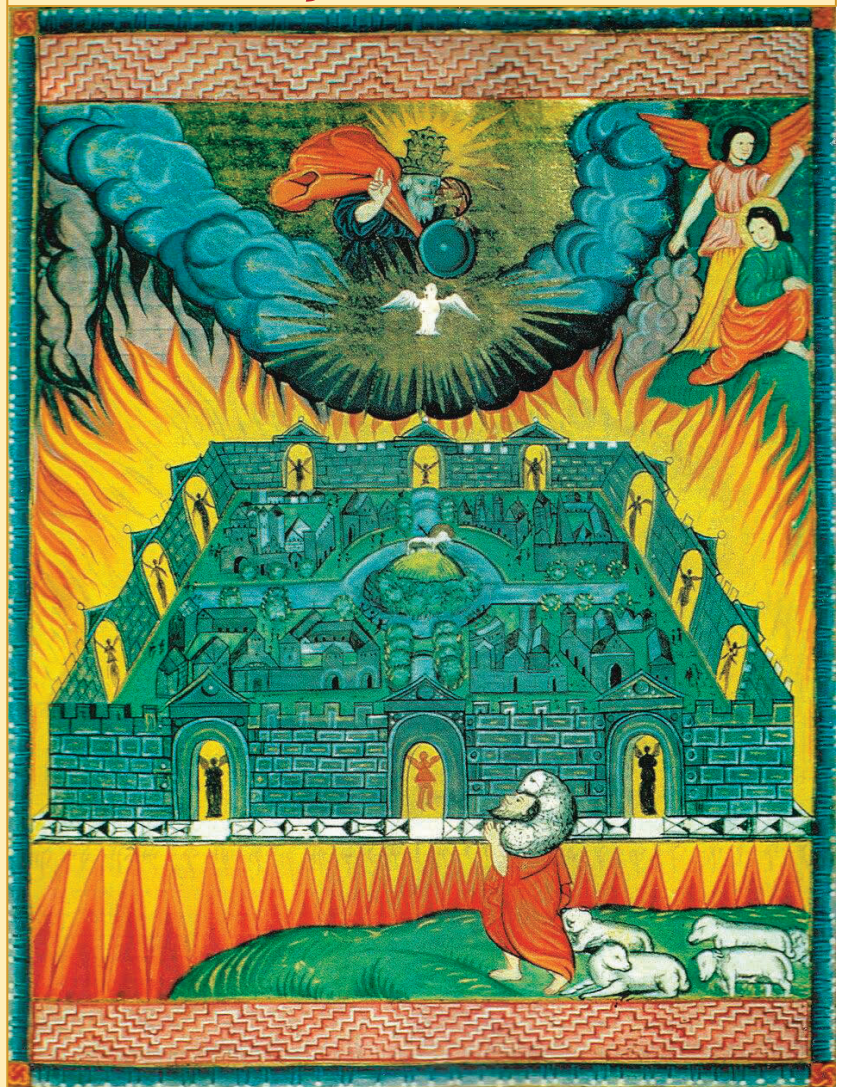

Sixth Sunday of Easter

First Reading: Acts 15:1-2, 22-29

Some men informed the Gentiles that they must be circumcised if they wished to be saved, because of the Old Laws. Disciples then went forth to tell the Gentiles to honor only those rules which were strictly necessary, such as abstaining from eating meat sacrificed to idols and illicit sexual union.

Second Reading: Revelation 21:10-14, 22-23

John depicts Jerusalem coming out of heaven, sparkling with the radiance of precious jewels. Angels were stationed at each of its twelve gates, and each gate bore the name of one tribe of Israel. The city had no temple, because God was its temple. The glory and light of God and the Lamb also replaced their need for the sun.

Gospel: John 14:23-29

Jesus tells his disciples, "Anyone who loves me will be true to my word." For those who do honor his word, both Jesus and God will love them and stay with them always. He also tells them that God will send the Holy Spirit in his place to give them the instructions they will need. Jesus then tells them that peace is his farewell gift to them.

Sexto Domingo de Pascua

Primera Lectura: Hechos 15:1-2, 22-29

La ciudad no tenía templo, pues Dios era su templo. La gloria y luz de Dios y el Cordero también reemplazaban la necesidad del sol.

Evangelio: San Juan 14:23-29

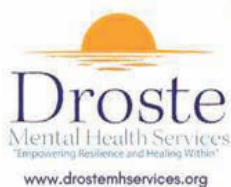

Marian Hymn for the Easter Season: The Regina Coeli



During the year, a Marian chant/hymn is offered here frequently as the final procession after Sunday Mass. There is an ancient, beautiful precedent for this in the liturgical worship of the Catholic Church. It symbolizes that the Blessed Virgin Mary is truly a mother to us, praying for us and encouraging us at all times as we return back into the world filled with both the word of God spoken to us in the Sacred Scripture in the Liturgy of the Word, and the Word of God consumed by us in the Liturgy of the Eucharist. The Blessed Mother not only carried our Lord during His development for nine months, but throughout her entire life, the Blessed Virgin Mary carried Jesus in her heart and soul wherever Our Lady went. We too should live our lives with that same attitude. Who better to give the world Jesus than His greatest disciple, Mother Mary? So too, we as disciples are called to proclaim Jesus wherever we go, whatever we do, and whomever we encounter. And when necessary, even use words!

During the Season of Easter, the favored chant/hymn prayer is the Regina Coeli or Queen of Heaven, Rejoice!

Please go to our website and click on the version of this beautiful chant. Listening to it repeatedly will help you familiarize yourself with it. The closing prayer in parentheses is usually never sung. — *Fr. JP*

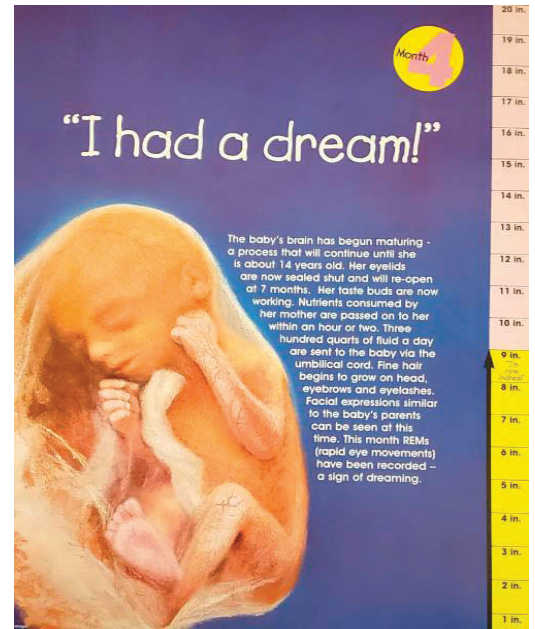

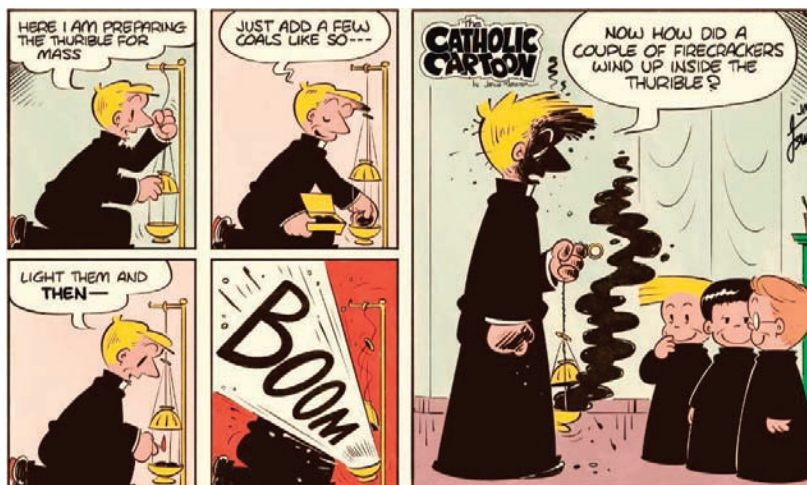

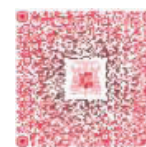
