Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading: Isaiah 66:18-21

Isaiah portrays a time when people from many nations will gather in Jerusalem and proclaim God's glory. God's messengers will teach many nations about God. Just as the Israelites bring offerings, these messengers will bring people from all nations to worship.

Second Reading: Hebrews 12:5-7, 11-13

The Hebrews are told that God disciplines those he loves. When a parent disciplines a child, the child usually learns what is expected of him. The Hebrews are encouraged to face life's trials as a form of discipline, and attempt to learn something from them.

Gospel: Luke 13:22-30

Jesus warns that the door to God's kingdom will be locked for those who ignored his wishes. Many people will come from all nations and take their place in God's kingdom. Others will not be recognized by God, and he will reject them.

During January, we started our Spiritual Adoption nine month cycle. Please continue to pray for the baby you have adopted.



Beginning this month the baby uses four senses. His eyelids open and close and the eyes look around. The baby can taste, touch, cough, yawn, and hiccup. He now recognizes his own mother's voice, and he responds when her voice reaches his ears. His grip is even stronger now than it will be after his birth. The hair on his head is growing longer and the downy covering on the rest of his body is disappearing. During this time the baby will receive antibodies from his mother providing him immunity to a wide variety of diseases.

He should summon the presbyters of the church, and they should pray over him and anoint [him] with oil in the name of the Lord, and the prayer of faith will save the sick person, and the Lord will raise him up. On Saturday, September 13, the vigil of the Solemnity of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, the parish church of St. John the Evangelist – St. Charles Borromeo will host a day of prayer for all those carrying the cross of suffering, whether in body, mind, or spirit. The day will include the following activities:

- 2:00 Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament
- 2:30 Penance and Reconciliation begins (English only)
- 3:00 Divine Mercy Chaplet and Holy Rosary
- 3:30 Litanies of the Sacred Heart and the Holy Name of Jesus
- 3:45 Penance and Reconciliation Ends
- 4:00 Personal Reverence with the Blessed Sacrament*
- 4:30 Benediction
- 5:00 The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass (Counts for Sunday Obligation). After the homily, the anointing of the sick will take place.

Penance and Reconciliation will be available in the afternoon. You do not need to attend all day to receive the anointing.

This is not a Charismatic healing service. It is a day of prayer and penance with Mass and the Anointing of the Sick. There will be no laying on of hands or praise and worship songs. The anointing is for those with chronic illnesses, disabilities, those before surgery, the elderly, individuals with mental health issues, or other infirmities

A basket will be placed on the table in front of the crucifix under the baldacchino. You may write your intentions to the Lord and place them in the basket. These intentions will remain before the altar throughout the entire weekend Masses during the Solemnity.

The parish must record the number of anointings performed that day.


