4th Sunday of Easter

First Reading: Acts 2:14a, 36-41

With great authority, Peter proclaims to the people that the Christ who was crucified is indeed the Messiah. Urging them to reform and be baptized in the name of Christ, three thousand responded to his words and were baptized.

Second Reading: 1 Peter 2:20b-25

This is a strong exhortation from Peter to the people to endure suffering for Christ as he did for them. Healed by his wounds, they have “returned to the shepherd.”

Gospel: John 10:1-10

Christ uses the beautiful image of the shepherd to describe his care for his sheep. He also says he is the sheepgate and promises that “Whoever enters through me will be safe.”

Es una segunda exhortación de Pedro al pueblo para ayudarlos a soportar el sufrimiento por Cristo, así como El lo hizo por ellos. Sanados por Sus heridas, ellos han “regresado al pastor.”

Evangelio: San Juan 10:1-10

Cristo utiliza la bella comparación con un pastor para describir su preocupación por sus ovejas. También dice que El es la puerta, y promete que “El que por mí entre será salvo”.

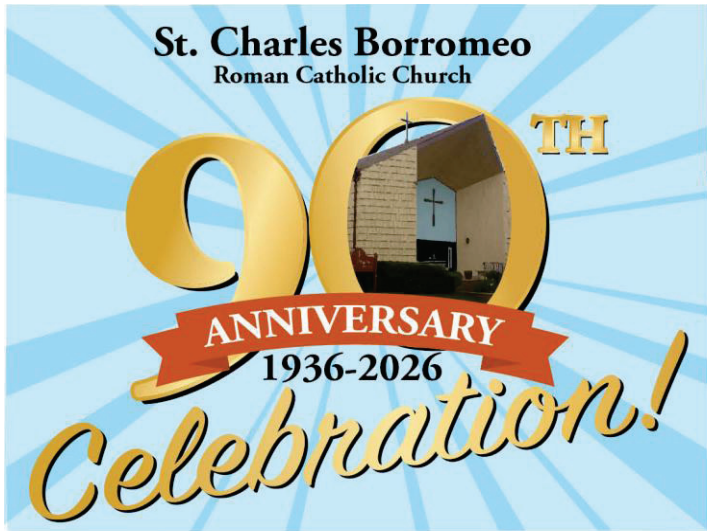
2026 MASS BOOK: We are now taking Mass requests for April, May, and June.

St. Gianna Beretta Molla (Apr. 28th)



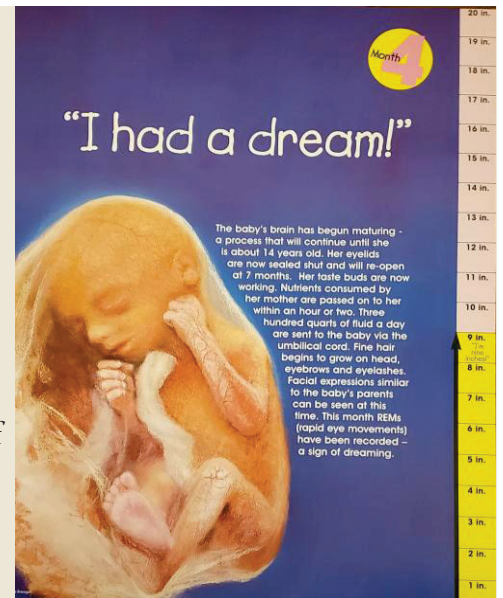

The baby's brain as begun maturing - a process that will continue until she is about 14 years old. Her eyelids are now sealed shut and will re-open at 7 months. Her taste buds are now working. Nutrients consumed by her mother are passed on to her with an hour or two. Three hundred quarts of fluid a day are sent to the baby via the umbilical cord. Fine hair begins to grow on head, eyebrows, and eyelashes. Facial expressions similar to the baby's parents can be seen at this time. This month REMs (rapid eye movements) have been recorded - a sign of dreaming.

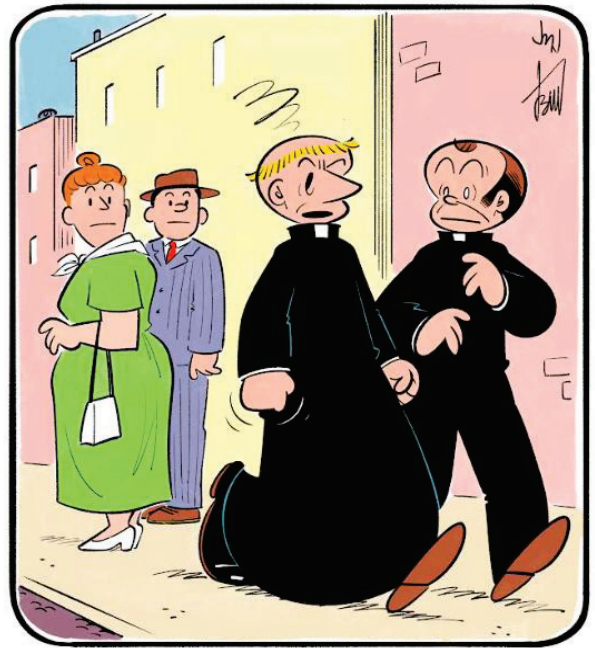
