





#### Dear Parishioners and Friends:

Today we remember the solemn consecration and dedication of our church by then Bishop Daniel Reilly on September 20, 2001, 20 years ago. The sacrifices and good works of our people were most instrumental in making all this happen. From a small corner church at the junction of Routes 20 and 31, with a capacity for 230 people, we were able to launch this new Church Complex, comprising a church with an 800 seating capacity, as well as a Hall with kitchen, Youth Center, Meeting Rooms, Food Pantry and residence for our priests all because of the selfless generosity of our good people. From conducting parish feasibility studies to polling our parishioners if they would be able to fund the new building, to setting up a building committee, engaging Architectural Innovations, and attaining the generous service of a Clerk of the Works; what was once a dream, has become a reality. Generous volunteers include but not limited to Nelson Sleeper, Scott Merrill, Richard Cayer, Rob Lemansky, David Wolkowicz, Janet Benoit, Bill Krukowski (RIP), Fred Houde, David Tittle along with his dad, Skip Czayka, Jack Olson, Hank Camosse, Frank and his son Mike Tiberii, Pete McNeaney and his son Mike; Rick Powell, Dave Barbale and his son Jim along with so many others too numerous to mention whose goodness and generosity have made possible what we cherish today.

Costing over \$6,000,000, having borrowed about \$4,000,000 from our Diocesan Bank and the remainder coming from the sales of the old church and rectory, our debt after 20 years is at \$1,800,000. We are paying a weekly mortgage of \$4,000.00 and also making extra payments from our Parish share of the Legacy of Hope (we just made a payment of \$20,000.00 in June).

We cannot help but praise and thank our God for the graces and blessings poured upon our faith community over these many years. We continue to thank and rejoice in the goodness of our parishioners and friends for their loving and generous support of our church. These past two years have presented new challenges to all of us as we negotiate the difficulties of a world wide pandemic. And through it all, I am so amazed and inspired at the resiliency of you, our faithful and loving parish family. Though we had to close down for several months and wait until it was "safe", you have always been present and I am most grateful. I am also inspired by our newest church family members who have added so generously to the spirit of joy and welcome hospitality which this Parish Church complex has inspired. May God's blessings be poured out on our entire community, harkening back to the awesome message given to St. Francis some 1,000 years ago to "rebuild My Church". It is our hope that not only have we built the building, but the actual CHURCH which is God's holy people.




