

SAINTS TO BE CANONIZED

The canonization of two contemporaries; Blessed Carlo Acutis a 15 year old millennial, and Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati takes place September 7 at St. Peter's in Rome. Both warrant our veneration as persons who have given witness to Jesus by their lives. Blessed Acutis, born in London in 1991, died in Italy of Leukemia in 2006. He was a soccer player and skier, and very adept with technology. He organized a wonderful study of the miracles of the Eucharist through the years. Blessed Pier Giorgio, born in Italy in 1901, died in 1925. He is known for his love of Jesus and actively fostering the social teachings of the church.
