

As Mary Tobin's obituary says "Mary actively cared for her family, ....continuing to serve her church and assisting the community...." Obviously, an obituary is only a short summary of one's life... but to say she served her church is an understatement and not an adequate description in Mary's case. Because she and her husband, Jack, were and are, such assets to our parish, I think it is appropriate to mention a couple ways Mary served our parish throughout the years. Mary was a member of the Altar Society and the Parish Council, serving several terms, including as the President. (I guess you can say she was our first female president!) She was the driving force behind annual rummage sales, spearheaded parish socials, including a Mother's Tea, and helped

host baby showers for young mothers (Birthright?). She made the baptism garments given our babies at baptism, and provided homemade quilts to many of the babies in the parish. Mary, as well as Jack, were on the church steering committee, responsible for the design and furnishing of our facility, and she and a couple other ladies instigated the scholarship program that our youth are still benefiting from today. Mary helped out at the rectory and did the bulletin (maybe the bookkeeping too?), for many years, and later was instrumental in hiring a parish secretary. Mary was a big supporter of funeral dinners, she very likely is one that helped get them started. The list goes on... These are only a few memories from one parishioner, many others can add to the list of ways Mary touched their lives. She had a big heart and she will be missed! (On a side note, one might add — when Mary called, you listened ③). It is not enough to simply say she served her church.... Mary lived and was the church we are all called to be. We are forever grateful to her and Jack for all they have done and continue to do for St. Pius X! Let us pray for her family, and especially her husband of 70 years!

### SCOTT HAHN'S REFLECTION....

Jesus this week calls us to train our hearts, to master our passions and emotions. And Jesus demands the full obedience of our hearts (see Romans 6:17). He calls us to love God with all our hearts, and to do His will from the heart (see Matthew 22:37; Ephesians 6:6). God never asks more of us than we are capable of. That is the message of this week's First Reading. It is up to us to choose life over death, to choose the waters of eternal life over the fires of ungodliness and sin. By His life, death, and resurrection, Jesus has shown us that it is possible to keep His commandments. In Baptism, He has given us His Spirit that His law might be fulfilled in us (Romans 8:4). The wisdom of the Gospel surpasses all the wisdom of this age that is passing away, St. Paul tells us in the Epistle. The revelation of this wisdom fulfills God's plan from before all ages.
