A Message from Preborn Jesus



Preborn Jesus Ministry

The ministry's vision is to save the lives of the preborn by helping their mothers relate to Mary nurturing the Preborn Jesus in her womb. Through the power of meditating on the Scripture passage of Luke 1:26-56, the mother would learn to trust God and say "yes" to the responsibility of being a mother to her preborn baby, which is God's precious gift to her.

Just as the umbilical cord is the lifeline between mother and child, so the rosary in the picture represents the spiritual connection between Mary and Jesus and their profound relationship as mother and Son. The umbilical cord is a source of physical life and the rosary is a source of spiritual life. Anyone who prays the rosary has a unique connection to Jesus and His mother Mary.

You are invited to pray the **Joyful Mysteries of the Rosary** as listed below:

1. **The Annunciation** – The Angel asks Mary to be the mother of Jesus, and she says, "yes".
2. **The Visitation** – Mary visits her cousin Elizabeth who is miraculously pregnant with John the Baptist.
3. **The Nativity** – Jesus, our Savior, is born.
4. **The Presentation in the Temple** – Jesus is presented in the Temple, as is the Jewish custom.
5. **The Finding in the Temple** – Jesus is found preaching in the temple with overwhelming wisdom at the age of twelve.

How to Pray the Rosary



1. Make the sign of the cross.
2. Holding the Crucifix, say an "Apostle's Creed".
3. On the first bead, say an "Our Father".
4. Say three "Hail Marys" on each of the next three beads.
5. Say the "Glory Be".
6. For each of the five decades, announce the Mystery, then say the "Our Father". While fingering each of the ten beads, say ten "Hail Marys" while meditating on the Mystery. Then say a "Glory Be" and a "Fatima Prayer". Repeat.
7. After saying the five decades, say the "Hail, Holy Queen, followed by this dialogue and prayer:
V. Pray for us, O holy Mother of God.
R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Let us pray: O God, whose only-begotten Son, by his life, death, and resurrection has purchased for us the rewards of eternal life, grant, we beseech, that while meditating on these mysteries of the most holy Rosary, of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise, through the same Christ our Lord, Amen.

The Prayers of the Rosary

Apostles Creed:

I believe in God, the Father Almighty,

Glory Be:

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son,

Fatima Prayer:

O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of
hell; lead all souls to heaven, especially those who are
most in need of your mercy.
