How to Pray the Rosary

A WORD FROM PREBORN JESUS




- 1. Make the Sign of the cross.
- 2. Holding the Crucifix, say the "Apostles' Creed".
- 3. On the first bead, say an "Our Father".
- 4. Say three "Hail Marys" on each of the next three beads.
- 5. Say the "Glory Be".
- 6. For each of the five decades, announce the Mystery, then say the "Our Father". While fingering each of the ten beads, say ten "Hail Marys" while meditating on the Mystery. Then say a "Glory Be" and a "Fatima Prayer". Repeat.
- 7. After saying the five decades, say the "Hail, Holy Queen", followed by this dialogue and prayer:
- V. Pray for us, O holy Mother of God.
- R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.


Let us pray: O God, whose only-begotten Son, by his life, death, and resurrection has purchased for us the rewards of eternal life, grant, we beseech Thee, that while meditating on these mysteries of the most holy Rosary, of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise, through the same Christ our Lord, Amen.

You are invited to pray the Joyful Mysteries of the Rosary as listed below:

- 1. The Annunciation The Angel Gabriel asks Mary to be the mother of Jesus and she says, "yes". Luke 1:26-38
- 2. The Visitation Mary visits Elizabeth who is miraculously pregnant with John the Baptist. Luke 1:39-56
- 3. The Nativity Jesus, our Savior, is born. Luke 2:1-14
- 4. The Presentation in the Temple Jesus is presented in the Temple, as is the Jewish custom. Luke 2:29-32
- 5. The Finding in the Temple Jesus is found preaching in the Temple with overwhelming wisdom at the age of twelve. Luke 2:48-52
