

FROM DEACON PETER

HOW DID LOVE DIE?

When Jesus Christ healed Simon's mother-in-law, she was cured...for a while...and eventually she passed from this life.

Lazarus was revived...for a while...and then he died again to await the true resurrection.

Countless numbers of people were healed by Christ, and eventually they all went to their graves.

As horrible and painful as physical suffering and bodily death are, there is something much worse-spiritual death...love's dying in a person's heart. For Christians, this is worse than bodily death. Why? Because a Christian professes Christ, who is love incarnate. The Word of the Father is love itself, so when a Christian loses love, he/she loses Christ, who is also the source of life.

There is absolutely no lack of things trying to kill the Christ in us. Just look at the times we're living in. Case in point--the masks. There are those who are proponents of them, and there are those who are against them...If there ever were a dividing line for love and hate...As if there weren't enough things in the world to cause discord, discontent, and distrust, the trivial matter of a face mask has suddenly become the next big phenomenon to drive the wedge of division between fellow human beings.

Now let me be clear, I am not saying that we should act with reckless abandon and be cavalier. However, I am saying that the culture would "love" nothing more than to have us believe that we can only live in the extremes of society. For goodness sake, what have we become? When we see someone *without* a mask, do we just immediately start condemning him/her as evil and uncaring of others? When we see someone *with* a mask, do we just start thinking of him/her as someone who has bought into the lie and given in to an illegitimate oppressor? When we find out someone close to us has contracted COVID, do we just scream "Unclean! Unclean!" and treat them like they're already dead to us?

My brothers and sisters, I can certainly die *from* a virus, but that is very different from *how* I die. I refuse to let a virus dictate *how* I die. When Joan of Arc was on trial, she was asked about whether she were in the state of grace, she replied, "If I am not, may God put me there; and if I am, may God so keep me." Because my hour will surely come one day, my sincere hope is that *how* I die would be in a state of grace. But in order to *die* in grace, I must strive to *live* in grace.

How do we live in grace? Lead with love. When we encounter someone who has a different understanding than we do on the masks (whether for or against), instead of condemning (maybe even as we're heading to Mass), try saying "Hi, how are you?" or "Have a blessed day." Start first with setting our own heart on the right path. Instead of living in fear and condemnation, reach for the alternative. Why have we become so afraid of death that we fear life?.. Simon's mother-in-law, Lazarus, countless others...None of us is promised tomorrow, and yet how many of us have our funeral arrangements set to go? What are living for? Do we live to die? NO. Remember that a virus, a politician, an insurrection, a freak accident may kill the body, but none has the ability to kill the soul...unless we allow it. Nothing and no one can rob Christ from our heart, but we can certainly abandon Him. So for the sake of heaven, don't let the world (illness, fear, hate, etc) rob us of eternal life...it's not worth it. The pearl of great price is much more valuable than anything this world can offer.


