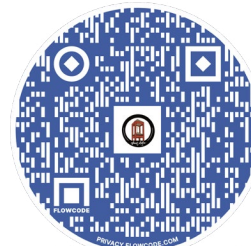

FROM YOUR PAROCHIAL VICAR

Dear family,

I love to read, especially classic literature. But during the last eight or nine years, I have had very little time to pursue extracurricular reading that interests me. I was certainly doing a lot of reading for six of those years in seminary, but that was mostly assigned reading necessary for my classes. Good stuff, for sure, but schoolwork nonetheless. Even when faced with the extensive “down time” of a retreat or vacation, I have found that I spend most of my free time praying (on retreats), catching up with friends (on vacations), and sleeping (on both). I always am over-ambitious with the books I bring with me; by the end of the vacation, I *might* have started reading one of them for a few chapters, at most. Last year, I was able to read a small handful of genuine ink-and-paper books purely for pleasure, but after all, we were in a lockdown without much else to do. (Which reminds me: you should look up Arthur C. Clarke’s short story “Quarantine” and read it—it’s science fiction, but it’s only approximately one page long! You can read it online.)

But there is another activity that takes up much of my time, whether for retreats, vacations, or everyday life: driving. And so, in the last 5 years or so, I began to answer my need for extracurricular reading by listening to audiobooks and podcasts, especially as I was driving. Nowadays I even listen to podcasts at mealtimes if Fr. Jared isn’t around. I listen to many different kinds of podcasts, but I have found many extremely interesting Catholic podcasts that I think do a great job of helping people (including me) to follow St. Paul’s advice to his favorite Christian community, the Philippians: “Finally, brethren, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is gracious, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, *think about these things*” (Phil. 4:8, RSV). And today, I would like to recommend a few of those podcasts to you, starting with our very own St. Luke podcast, aptly named “**St. Luke the Evangelist Catholic Church.**” Look us up on a podcast app like Podbean, Spotify, or Google Podcasts—and look up a few of these other podcasts I would like to recommend also!

Pints with Aquinas – hosted by Matt Fradd, who discusses all sorts of Catholicism-related topics. On this podcast, he talks about many topics of our modern life, as seen through the piercingly clarifying lens of St. Thomas Aquinas. Some of Fradd’s topics of expertise are: arguments for the existence of God, advice to overcome pornography, and of course the writings of St. Thomas Aquinas, especially on the virtues.

Godsplaining – hosted by various Dominican Friars of the Province of St. Joseph (Eastern US Province), who also discuss a wide array of topics from a Catholic and Thomistic perspective. Maybe you want to learn about the virtue of justice or prudence, or Christopher Nolan movies. Maybe you have questions about the COVID vaccines. These episodes, each under 40 minutes long, are great for beginners as well as for going a little deeper. My favorite is Fr. Gregory Pine; he speaks really fast but also really precisely.

Pater Familias – hosted by Todd and Stephen (pronounced “Steffen”) Sylvester, a father-son duo who are both awesome Catholic dads sharing their thoughts about life, fatherhood (the title means “father of the family”), marriage, current events, pop culture, and other random stuff, from their home studio near Mobile, AL. I’m proud to have known them all my life and to call them friends. The discussions they have can be very thought-provoking, even if you don’t agree with them (they don’t agree with each other most of the time, although by the end of their discussion they usually come to some agreement). And sometimes at the end Stephen plays and sings one of the many thought-provoking songs he has written.

That’s all for now; more recommendations in the future! Happy listening!

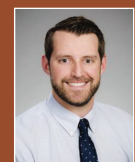
