### FROM YOUR PASTOR

Dear St. Luke Family,

Jesus sounds pretty angry in today's Gospel. He tells us that we have to give up the things that are wounding God's Sacred Heart and destroying our own. But that's not us, right? We come to Church every Sunday. That can't happen to us, right? But Jesus quotes Isaiah and gives us good reason to think long and hard about our relationship with the Lord. "This people honors me with their lips," he says, "But their hearts are far from me..." How do we know if we are far from God? I can help you diagnose it with one question...

### How is your prayer life?

If you're at Mass every Sunday, but that's the only time you're spending with God, you're probably further away from God than you want to be. Imagine a marriage where the spouses talk once a week for an hour... It's just not going to be the love that either of you deserve.

I've been working with some pretty awesome people in our parish to bring you great opportunities to develop your prayer life or even better - *improve* your faith life. 


#### METAL-AFIRE BREAKOUT GROUP JUST FOR MEN



### LORD, TEACH ME TO PRAY GROUPS START SOON!

Have no anxiety at all! But come pray with us giving thanks and praise to our Lord for everything!! Then, the peace that surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus!!! Philippians 4:6-7

Lord, Teach Me To Pray is a 3-part Ignatian prayer series developed to meet the desire for on-going spiritual growth; for an appropriate response to the call to holiness; and for a deeper commitment to Jesus Christ as Lord. In facilitated faith-sharing prayer communities, the Lord, himself, teaches us to pray. Part 1: Praying Christian Virtues: Introduces you to the meditative and contemplative way of prayer devised by St. Ignatius of Loyola, enabling you to further develop your prayer life. This 12-week program is facilitated in a group setting, meets for 2 hours once a week, and requires fifteen minutes of daily prayer on assigned scriptures. (No prerequisites) Part 2: My 19th Annotation: This communal approach allows you to do the full Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius of Loyola. You will pray for all the graces that are offered while experiencing the direction of the Holy Spirit through weekly Faith Sharing on your daily prayer. This 30-week program is facilitated in a group setting, meets for 2 hours once a week, and requires thirty to forty-five minutes of daily prayer on assigned scriptures. (Part 1 is a prerequisite.) All Groups are for women, and a \$20 donation for materials is gratefully appreciated!

### HAVE YOU BEEN DIVORCED AND NEED HELP GETTING AN ANNULMENT?

Many people ask, If it's hard enough trying to get through the heartache of a difficult divorce, why in the world would I want to go through the process of an annulment?"

It's an easy answer... because of the healing.

The reason a divorce aches so much is because once, your life was made up of two hearts. When that spouse pulled away, you were left bleeding and wounded. An annulment, at its very core, is the examination of a marriage covenant. The process of an annulment gives you a chance to really take a long hard look at your marriage from the start to finish, digging deeply into all the variety of feelings, behaviors, and habits that hurt you - and that caused you to hurt your previous spouse, and it helps you to pinpoint how to move forward. It may also give you a sense of closure that the divorce never did, leaving you capable of starting fresh and making better choices that are healthy and life-affirming.

The Archdiocese of New Orleans will offer a workshop for persons seeking an annulment in the Catholic Church or for persons responding to an annulment at St. Rita School Library in the Msgr. Champagne Complex located at 7100 Jefferson Hwy. in Harahan. It's a long way to drive, but WELL WORTH the time and gas. The series will be FIVE (5) Tuesdays: Sept. 14, 21, 28, and Oct. 5, 12, from 7:30 p.m. to 9 p.m. The materials are only \$25, and the workshop will be conducted by lay ministers and clergy who work with the Tribunal here in New Orleans and/or who have been through the annulment process and have a wealth of experience. They will share their own personal stories and make themselves available to you to talk or answer questions after each session. The sessions give you time to work in a quiet, peaceful setting to navigate the process and paperwork, and give you the ability to share the experience with others who are going through the same thing and experiencing similar emotions. This is an amazing opportunity to move on with your life - and find the peace you've been needing. 
