This weekend we hear the wonderful story of Mary's Visitation with her cousin Elizabeth, when John the Baptist leapt for joy while still in the womb. Christ is already causing great rejoicing before He is even born to the earth.

As we continue to seek and ask for that joy, we are aware that the celebration of Christmas enters abruptly into our lives. In other words, Christ's birth changes everything. However, celebrating Christmas Mass does not remove our obligation to keep holy the Lord's Sabbath on Sundays. Thus, we have the blessing and the obligation of celebrating Sunday Mass (the Feast of the Holy Family) as well. Your options for Sunday are our regular Sunday schedule:

#### IMPORTANT CHARITABLE DONATIONS NEWS:

Over the last couple of years, we have seen major changes in the Federal Tax Code. These changes have had a multitude of effects on both individuals and couples as they try to plan their finances and the resulting tax effects. One such change has been the increase is the standard deduction for all categories of filers.

Due to an increased standard deduction, certain individuals and couples alike can no longer claim a full itemized deduction for charitable gifts. There is still a way you can contribute to your favorite charity and effectively reduce your taxable income; A tax-free IRA charitable rollover. Such a rollover offers those that have reached the age of "required minimum distribution (RMD)" make a deduction to their favorite charity and effectively reduce their taxable income. They can direct the custodian of their

Traditional IRA to execute a charitable rollover of their RMD to their favorite charity up to \$100,000 without the RMD being considered a taxable distribution. This will satisfy the annual RMD without increasing taxable income.

This tax break may not be for everyone and anyone considering such a contribution should seek advice from their tax professional to see if such a move is right for them.






