FROM YOUR PASTOR

Hello, St. Luke family! And happy New Year!

In so many ways, God has blessed us this past year:

He gave us this Year of the Eucharist to be a time when we can grow closer to and dive deeper into our relationship with our Lord. We focused on recruiting regular adorers in our Adoration Chapel, which we successfully achieved; however, we have a few spots recently opened up.

We were given this year to honor all fathers, through the Year of St. Joseph. And we focused on Christ being our one true Shepherd. We've even seen the beginnings of our Good Shepherd fountain being constructed.

Our campus has had lots of upgrades: A new beautiful door on the Candle House, a new lobby in the parish office, a new maintenance cart for our awesome maintenance crew, new speakers in the courtyard, the clearing of the brush in front of the Family Life Center, new angel Holy Water fonts in church, new landscaping throughout the main area of campus, updating gutters throughout campus, an outdoor Nativity scene, and the donating of six new statues for outdoor prayer.

In terms of spirituality, we've also seen a lot of new and exciting things happening: our FIRE (Family Involved Religious Education) program with over 400 participants each formation night; our Family Bash, with 5K run, pumpkin patch, contests, and live entertainment; a more streamlined process for all of our sacraments; our METAL and ENDOW groups, focusing on true masculinity and femininity; "Fulfillment: A Eucharistic Experience," during Lent; our May Crowning and Procession; our Corpus Christi and Christ the King Eucharistic Processions; our Holy Hours for victims of abuse; our Benediction services on Fridays of Advent, and so much more.

God has done so many amazing things! But now we set our eyes on what is still possible, and what God is still calling us to be and do.

This coming year, we will finish up a lot of the projects we have been anticipating: the repairing of the maintenance roof and rebuilding of the maintenance canopy, the installation of all outdoor statues, the completion of our campus landscaping, the clearing of the brush throughout the rest of the campus, among other things.

But what is most exciting is that this year we are in our 40th year as a parish family. And so, in honor of this great year, myself, the staff, and our pastoral and finance councils are focusing on future planning — where is God calling St. Luke to be in 5 years? In 10 years? In 40 more years?

He has so much in store for us and for you specifically. Ask how you can participate more fully in this amazing parish family we have been blessed with.

FROM YOUR PAROCHIAL VICAR

Dear friends,

Happy Epiphany, and Happy New Year! And, if you were traveling elsewhere on Christmas and missed us, I hope your Christmas Day was a holy and joyful one! Merry Christmas!

I hope you will go home today with a piece of blessed chalk and use it to bless your house for the new year, using the prayers for the Epiphany blessing included in this bulletin! On this feast that occurs so close to the beginning of the calendar year, having an Epiphany house blessing is a traditional practice among Catholic families to dedicate the new year to Christ and to put their family and home under His protection in the new year. On this feast on which we celebrate the revelation of Christ as the promised King who would be a light to the gentiles (the nations), especially through the adoration of the three foreign Wise Men who followed the light of the star until it led them to Jesus, the Light of the World, your family can take this blessed chalk and inscribe above the front door of your home the initials of the three Wise Men who worshipped Christ, praying that, like the travels of the Wise Men, your comings and go-ings will always be guided by Christ throughout the year. The father of the family or whoever is head of the household should lead the prayer, and if there are three other family members present, they can take on the roles of the three Wise Men, Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar, during the blessing!

Speaking of Catholic traditions, don't forget: for us Catholics, the Christmas season only began a week ago, even if most people started celebrating right after Thanksgiving Day...so don't take down your decorations just yet! There are different opinions on how long to leave up your Christmas lights and tree, but as Catholics we are in the season of Christmas *at least* until next Sunday, the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, at which point we will enter the season of Ordinary Time. Seems so fast... But according to centu-ries of Catholic tradition and culture, until recent years the Christmas season lasted until February 2, the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, also known as "Candlemas," so if you want to leave them up until then (like my family), go for it! I think we could use a little extra Christmas this year.

For those of you who decided this Christmas that now was the time to recommit to coming to Sunday Mass every week, I'm so glad you're here with us! St. Luke is your church family, and we haven't been the same without you. Please come say hi to me or Fr. Jared after Mass, especially if we're new to you! I will pray for you to continue in what is probably the most important "new year's resolution" you will make this year. And if it has been a while since you went to confession, maybe make an appointment to meet with Fr. Jared or me, especially if you're thinking, "This could take a while..." or come to one of our scheduled Reconciliation times in church (see the first page of this bulletin).

I am very excited to promote our new Civil Marriage Initiative to any of you who are married legally but have never been married in the Catholic Church. Just see the Civil Marriage Initiative page in this bulletin, and use the QR code to go online, *or* fill out the slip and turn it in to the collection or hand it directly to a priest, because every Christian husband and wife should have the grace of this beautiful Sacrament of Matrimony! Fr. Jared and I are here to walk with you and help you take the next steps toward this sacra-ment. Here is no cause for shame, only hope!

May the Year of Our Lord 2022 be truly a year of grace for you and yours! Happy New Year!

EPIPHANY HOUSE BLESSING

Leader: God's peace be in this home,

All: And in all who live here.

Leader: The star burned like a flame, pointing the way to God, the King of kings; the wise men saw the sign and brought their gifts in homage to their great King.

All: My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord, my spirit rejoices in God my Savior; for He has looked with favor on his lowly servant. From this day all generations shall call me blessed: the Almighty has done great things for me, and holy is His Name. He has mercy on those who fear Him in every generation. He has shown the strength of His arm, He has scattered the proud in their conceit. He has cast down the mighty from their thrones and has lifted up the lowly. He has filled the hungry with good things and the rich he has sent away empty. He has come to the help of His servant Israel for He has remembered His promise of mercy, the promise He made to our fathers, to Abraham and his children forever. Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

All: The star burned like a flame, pointing the way to God, the King of kings; the wise men saw the sign and brought their gifts in homage to their great King.

Leader: Many shall come from Sheba.

All: Bearing gold and incense. Leader: O Lord, hear my prayer. All: And let my cry come unto Thee.

Leader: Let us pray.

O God, who by the guidance of a star did this day reveal your Only Begotten Son to the Gentiles, grant that we who know You by faith may be brought to the contemplation of the heavenly majesty, through the same Christ, Our Lord.

All: Amen.

All: Be enlightened and shine forth, O Jerusalem, for thy light is come, and upon thee is risen the glory of the Lord, Jesus Christ, born of the Virgin Mary.

Leader: Nations shall walk in your light, and kings in the brilliance of your rising. **All:** And the glory of the Lord is risen upon you.

Leader: Let us pray. O Lord, Almighty God, bless this house + that it may become a shelter of health, chastity, self-conquest, humility, goodness, mildness, obedience to the commandments, and thanksgiving to God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Upon this house and those who dwell here, may Your blessing remain forever, through Christ our Lord. **All:** Amen.

The father of the family and the three "kings" proceed to the front door with blessed chalk. The father reads the corresponding words as the kings inscribe their initials onto the lintel.

Final inscription on lintel should read:

```
20 + C + M + B + 22
```

Leader: Almighty God, incline your ear. May you bless us and all who are gathered here. Send your holy angel who will defend us and fill with grace all who live here. **All:** Amen.

Conclude by singing "We Three Kings" and/or sprinkling holy water throughout the house.





IMPORTANT CHARITABLE DONATIONS NEWS:

Over the last couple of years, we have seen major changes in the Federal Tax Code. These changes have had a multitude of effects on both individuals and couples as they try to plan their finances and the resulting tax effects. One such change has been the increase is the standard deduction for all categories of filers.

Due to an increased standard deduction, certain individuals and couples alike can no longer claim a full itemized deduction for charitable gifts. There is still a way you can contribute to your favorite charity and effectively reduce your taxable income; A tax-free IRA charitable rollover. Such a rollover offers those that have reached the age of "required minimum distribution (RMD)" make a deduction to their favorite charity and effectively reduce their taxable income. They can direct the custodian of their Traditional IRA to execute a charitable rollover of their RMD to their favorite charity up to \$100,000 without the RMD being considered a taxable distribution. This will satisfy the annual RMD without increasing taxable

income. This tax break may not be for everyone and anyone considering such a contribution should seek advice from their tax professional to see if such a move is right for them.
