FROM YOUR PASTOR

Hello, St. Luke family!

In order to aid you in your Lenten observance this year — aiming to acquire mastery over our vices and replacing them with virtue — we have planned the following events, which I hope will draw you more closely into union with Christ:

1. MARCH 13 | FIRE night

Our monthly night of formation, family, and food will be focused on the practicalities of denying ourselves, taking up our crosses, and following the Lord.

2. MARCH 23 | Taize Prayer Service

Our annual Taize service is a music-led prayer experience by which we draw closer to the Lord through repetitive and meditative song.

3. MARCH 25-27 | 40 Hours Devotion

Beginning at 2 pm on Friday and ending before the 7:30 am Sunday Mass, these 40 hours are meant to inspire a greater devotion to our Lord in the Holy Eucharist, as well as gain more committed adorers to our Adoration Chapel.

4. MARCH 28-30 | Lenten Mission ft. Dr. Tom Neal

At 7 pm, three nights in a row, Dr. Tom Neal (professor at Notre Dame Seminary in New Orleans and a writer for *Word on Fire*) will be leading us in a series on how we are capable and worthy of carrying the Cross with Christ, while teaching us how to do so well as lay people.

5. APRIL 6 | Lenten Penance Service

At our normal Confession time — Wednesday from 5-6:30 pm — we will have multiple priests available for Confession.

6. APRIL 10 | FIRE night

Our monthly night of formation, family, and food will be focused on how the Mass is meant to empower us to overcome our sins and grow in holiness.

7. APRIL 14 | Holy Thursday - Mass of the Lord's Supper (7 pm)

This annual remembrance of our Lord's Last Supper, the Institution of the Eucharist and the Priesthood, is meant to remind us of the treasure we have been given in the Eucharist, but also how unworthy we are to receive Him.


8. APRIL 15 | Good Friday - Solemn Service (3 pm), Mary's Way of the Cross (5pm), and Living Way of the Cross (7 pm) are each meant to aid us in entering more deeply into the reality of Christ's sacrifice for us on the Cross.

9. APRIL 16 | Easter Vigil (8 pm)

The high point in the life of the Church is the celebration of Christ our Light entering our darkness and illuminating us, setting us afire with resurrected love. Christ will baptize and bring into Communion with His Church many amazing people this year.

All these, in addition to our Fish Frys (5-8 pm) and Stations of the Cross (6:30 pm) on Fridays in Lent, I hope will provide helpful fuel to be set ablaze at Easter. Know of my prayers for a prayerful and intentional Lenten season!

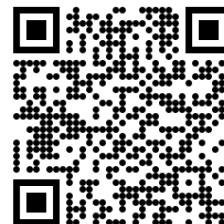

Anointing of the sick

ANOINTING OF THE SICK + HOSPITAL PASTORAL VISITS

If you or a loved one is ill or injured, facing a surgery or the birth of a child, or gravely sick and in danger of dying, you can benefit from an Anointing of the Sick. But how does that work? And does that mean I am dying if a priest comes to give an anointing?

The beautiful sacrament of the Sick was instituted by Christ Himself for the hoped-for effect that, if it be God's will, the person can be physically healed of illness. But even if there is no physical healing, the primary effect of the sacrament is a spiritual healing by which the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or medical distress or the frailty of old age. If you are at a local hospital, you can ask the hospital chaplain (the nurse can locate them for you) to call a Catholic

priest on duty. You can also call our office at 985-641-6429 (**press 1**). If you know that you will be heading to the hospital, or if you are home after an illness, call our office Monday through Friday, and let one of our front desk ambassadors know you would like to schedule an anointing. Every call requesting an anointing is taken *very seriously* - so much so, that someone answers those calls day or night.

Now, it's important to remember that as devoted as our priests are to caring for our parish, they are also not able to simply *know* that you need a pastoral visit or an anointing. They respect your privacy, and like all sacraments, they have to wait for *you* to make the request. It's also very important that the person requesting the anointing has the permission to speak for the person who needs it. A priest cannot give an anointing to a patient who does not want it - or to a patient who is not Catholic, even if the family of the patient want it. It is necessary to always respect the personal dignity of every patient.

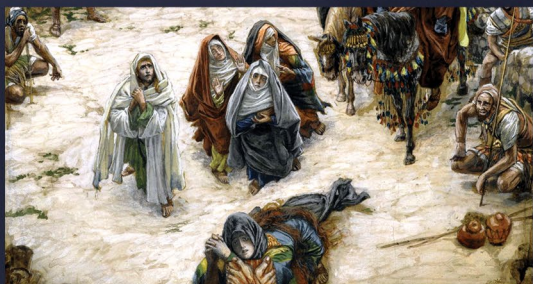

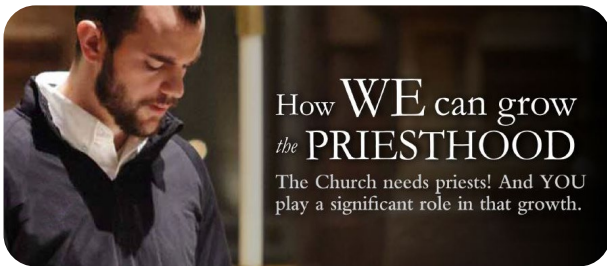

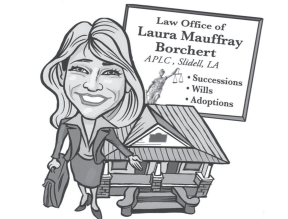
