I want to begin by thanking each one of you for the warm welcomes and kind greetings! I love that this parish is a large family, and I cannot express my gratitude for all of you welcoming me into it. BUILD A NEW MARRIAGE

The Retrouvaille Program is for Married Couples Struggling in their Relationship



The Challenge of Marriage in Today's Society

This program is for couples with marital problems that want marriage help. Those who are considering marriage separation and those who are already separated or divorced are encouraged to consider the Retrouvaille Program. There is always hope of reviving your relationship. Some couples come to Retrouvaille during the initial signs of a marriage problem. Other couples are in a state of despair and hopelessness when they attend the program. Many lawyers and judges send couples to Retrouvaille as a prerequisite to filing for a divorce or rendering final decisions. Many

marriage counselors and family therapists send their clients to Retrouvaille as a prerequisite to counseling. These professionals know that the tools of communication in marriage taught in the program are often what couples need. It's for husbands and wives and is not designed nor intended for couples in a cohabitating relationship.

Three Phases

Phase 1: The Retrouvaille Weekend Experience

Retrouvaille begins with a weekend experience where couples are helped to re-establish communication and gain new insights into themselves as individuals and as a couple. They're typically held at either a local hotel or a retreat facility, and there are presentations by 3 couples and a priest/minister team. You'll find courage and strength in the realization that you are not alone in your struggle, but you won't be asked to share your own problems with anyone else. You will be encouraged to put the past behind you and to look beyond the hurt and pain to rediscover each other in a new and positive way. You'll discover tools to help communication, forgiveness, and trust in your marriage to regrow. The weekend isn't a spiritual or marriage retreat. It's an opportunity to meet other couples who are where you are now - and who have learned to move into a better future together. After each session, you and your spouse will get to talk things over with your new skills and have time to reflect individually and together.

Phase 2: Postweekend Sessions

Once you head home, we're not going to abandon you. Through a series of follow-up sessions, you begin the permanent healing process. Let's face it: you're not going to fix years of pain and suffering in a weekend. The postweekend sessions include a series of 2-hour talks over 6 or 12 week periods by additional couples that expand on what you learned at the weekend. Most couples find that this is the most productive components of the program. The sessions are crucial and even more critical to the healing process, because the techniques you learned on the weekend are further developed, and you begin to explore the additional areas of marriage relationship.

Phase 3: Monthly Support (CORE)

The final phase is a monthly small-group support meeting, called Happy Couple CORE (Continuing Our Retrouvaille Experience). It allows for a casual and supportive interaction with other couples who have attended the Retrouvaille program. This monthly meeting continues to reinforce the communication tools learned on the weekend and it is a positive and welcoming space that allows couples to form strong and lasting bonds as they continue to heal their marriages.

The next Retrouvaille weekend will be June 24 - 26, 2022, and the cost is \$250.00 per couple.

* The registration fee is per couple, and is non-refundable, as it covers the initial deposit for the weekend. The registration fee does not cover the full cost of the Program. We are a self-supporting, non-profit organization. On the weekend, you will have the opportunity to make a voluntary donation to cover your full Program expenses. The registration couple will be able to provide an estimated total cost for the Program, as expenses vary based on the number of couples attending. No one is ever denied the chance to heal their marriage due to financial challenges and assistance is available.
