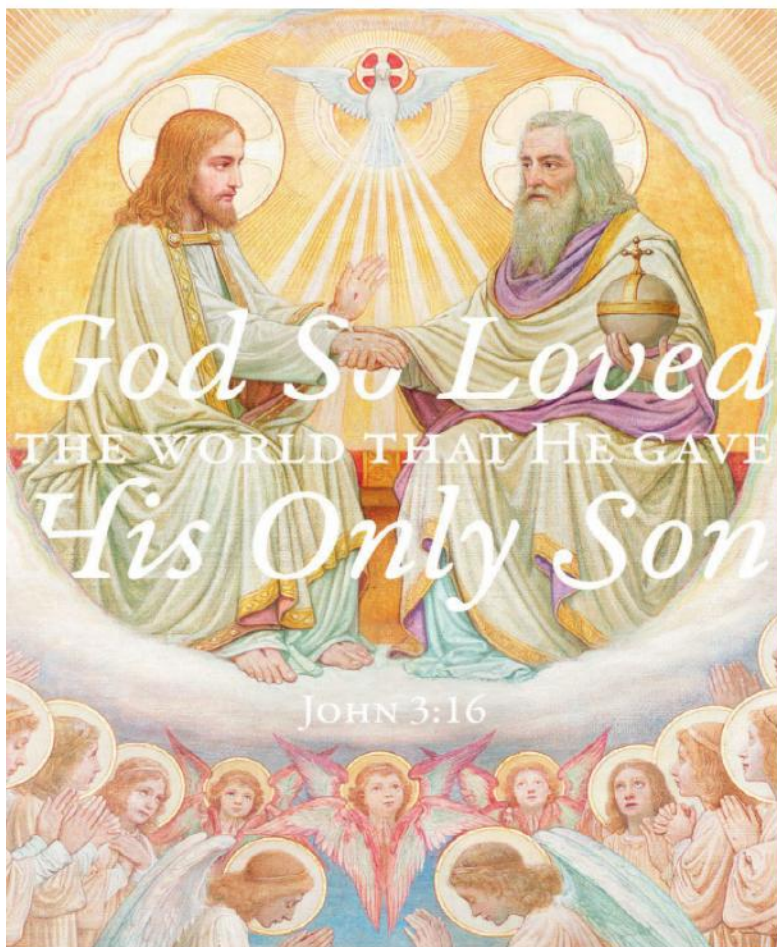

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity



MOST HOLY TRINITY

This is the Solemnity of a mystery. The One God is an inner life Three - The Father, The Son, and The Holy Spirit.

In the first reading, Moses meets the Lord on Mount Sinai - and delivers to His people the message of ONE God who is rich in kindness and slow to anger. In the second reading, St. Paul encourages us to live in the love of God and in peace with one another. And finally, in the Gospel, Jesus tells Nicodemus of the Father's love - and introduces us to a love like no other: a Father who gives His only Son that we might never die.

A mystery in the Church is not a Sherlock Holmes mystery. It's a SAINT mystery. It's something that only God can reveal - and which His people embrace. Visit the Catechism and read about the Holy Trinity in paragraphs 232-266.

FROM YOUR PASTOR 2

Hey, St. Luke family,

This Summer, I bet you're pulling out the whole family for a vacation at the beach or at the pool, or taking the kiddos on that cross country trip to see amazing sights or visit family you haven't seen in a while. Maybe you're taking your boo on a long awaited weekend or just spending the hot months somewhere cooler - and less, well, mosquito-y.

Some of my fondest memories include a family trip. My parents didn't get a lot of vacation time - working for the Church means that you're needed back home - but, they always made time to spend time with us. *Family is important.* No matter what you're doing at work, trust me, at the end of your life, what you'll hold closest to your heart are the moments spent with the people you love - and who love you.

In a lot of ways, that's what this weekend is all about. The importance of family.

Saint Pope John Paul II said something pretty amazing about the inner life of God: "It has been said, in a beautiful and profound way, that our God in his deepest mystery is not a solitude, but a family, since he has in himself fatherhood, sonship and the essence of the family, which is love. This subject of the family is not, therefore, extraneous to the subject of the Holy Spirit." Think about that. In your deepest relationships with your parents, with your sons and daughters, and with your siblings, you are literally living out the love of God and becoming images of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit together.

Lately, I have been hearing more and more about sons and daughters who are abandoning their parents. Parents abandoning their children with their parents. My heart breaks when I hear this. Instagram pundits and self-proclaimed "therapists" are more and more encouraging young adults and young families to tear away from the parents who raised them, as if forgiveness, reconciliation, and reunification are not possible.

Let me share an important reality with you. Parents let down their children every single day. Sons and daughters let their parents down every single day. Siblings let each other down every single day - but **GOD IS ABLE TO RECONCILE FAMILIES EVERY SINGLE DAY.**

If your son or daughter says that his or her heart is broken by something you have done - or failed to do - *ask for forgiveness.* If your parents have failed you or hurt you, and they come to you asking for a chance to start again - *forgive them.* If you've been estranged with your brother or your sister, let the anger go, and reach out to them in forgiveness and in the request for forgiveness.

Nothing is more important than the love between you, and on this Solemnity of the Holy Trinity - of our Great God - from Whom our love comes, let your hearts be drawn closer to one another in gentleness and hope. Give each other that seven-times-seventieth chance that Jesus asked of us, and make this the Summer you remember forever.
