

HOLY FAMILY

A family is a story of selfless love and a school of prayer. In the readings today, God calls us to examine the role of the family as a place where God's promises are fulfilled.

In the first reading, God promises Abraham that his faith will be rewarded with a family from whom blessings for the world will come. In the second reading, St. Paul reminds us that Christ's love in our hearts give us the virtues needed for a holy life. And in the Gospel, the Holy Family come to the temple to present Jesus - and God enters the world to keep His consistent promise of mercy.



When Jesus tells us to forgive even our enemies, we might consider beginning in our own families. So often, it's easier to forgive a stranger than someone we expect to love us. Families are schools of forgiveness, because they are the only place where we can't easily avoid the person we need to forgive. Is there something driving a wedge in your family? Take it to confession and ask God to help heal what's hurting.

Hey, Saint Luke Family!

FROM YOUR PASTOR 2

At some point this Christmas season — and yes, it's still Christmas in the Church — come and take a look at the Nativity in front of our FLC. I want to invite you into a powerful fact.

Often, we spend a lot of time focusing on the image of the Blessed Mother, holding the tiny little Infant surrounded by shepherds, and (in a week) visited by the Magi. But look for another face: a gentle, protecting, loving face — the face of the man we call Joseph. "Blessed be Saint Joseph, [Mary's] most chaste spouse," as the Divine Praises laud.

A family needs a husband and a father. God the Father knew the need for a Saint Joseph in the very human life of His Son. A child needs strong arms to hold him or her, and a male voice to speak quiet wisdom and offer shelter against the roughness of the world. A wife needs a faithful husband to protect, encourage, and love her.

Look, I know that sometimes on this side of Eden, families struggle with broken hearts; and I also know that there are some profoundly good women in this parish raising children and grandchildren without a father or a grandfather to be that sturdy shelter they need. This impels me to be an even more devoted spiritual father for you, to help provide for you.

All families need good men. The sadness is also that there are very many good men who never got the chance to be the men they wanted to be, because they lacked role models, opportunities, and support when they needed them. That's why I try to be a spiritual father to the men of our parish, too.

It's hard being a good man in this world, though, and what's more, it's hard finding other good men to strengthen our virtue, empower our holiness, and support us in being the men God calls us to be.

That's why this coming February, our Archdiocese is putting on its annual Men's Conference at St. Catherine of Siena in Metairie. You'll see the information in this bulletin and on our website. I want to formally invite EVERY. SINGLE. MAN. of our parish to go. If you're married. If you're thinking about being married. If you're divorced. If you've never been married. If you think God is calling you to a religious vocation. If you're a dad of boys. If you're a dad of girls. If your kids are taller than you. If you're a brand new dad...

I want you to go.

I want you to go because I want you to find out that you're not the only guy trying to be a good man in the world. I want you to know that the whole Church — and especially this parish family — has your back, that we want you to succeed, and that we are here to help you find purpose in your life.

If we can get more than 10 guys to go, we get \$10 off the \$45 registration, but I want there to be at least 40 guys from our parish willing to go. Invite a friend. Ask if someone needs a ride, and offer to drive someone else from our parish. If you can sponsor another guy that might not otherwise be able to go, I welcome your generosity. If your neighbor, or your brother, or your best friend, or your dad needs to go, bring him.

This year, let's be a powerful presence at that conference. Men's Club. Knights. That Man Is You. Conquest. Young Adult. Take heart. Have courage. And let's get going. There's a world out there that needs us.



READING 1: Gn 15:1-6; 21:1-3

The word of the LORD came to Abram in a vision, saying: "Fear not, Abram! I am your shield; I will make your reward very great."

But Abram said, "O Lord GOD, what good will your gifts be, if I keep on being childless and have as my heir the steward of my house, Eliezer?" Abram continued, "See, you have given me no offspring, and so one of my servants will be my heir."

Then the word of the LORD came to him:

"No, that one shall not be your heir; your own issue shall be your heir." The Lord took Abram outside and said, "Look up at the sky and count the stars, if you can. Just so," he added, "shall your descendants be."

Abram put his faith in the LORD, who credited it to him as an act of righteousness.

The LORD took note of Sarah as he had said he would; he did for her as he had promised. Sarah became pregnant and bore Abraham a son in his old age, at the set time that God had stated. Abraham gave the name Isaac to this son of his whom Sarah bore him.

GOSPEL: Lk 1:26-38

When the days were completed for their purification according to the law of Moses, They took him up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord, just as it is written in the law of the Lord, Every male that opens the womb shall be consecrated to the Lord, and to offer the sacrifice of a pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons, in accordance with the dictate in the law of the Lord.

Now there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon. This man was righteous and devout, awaiting the consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was upon him. It had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he should not see death before he had seen the Christ of the Lord. He came in the Spirit into the temple; and when the parents brought in the child Jesus to perform the custom of the law in regard to him, He took him into his arms and blessed God, saying:

"Now, Master, you may let your servant go in peace, according to your word, for my eyes have seen your salvation, which you prepared in sight of all the peoples, a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel."

The child's father and mother were amazed at what was said about him; and Simeon blessed them and said to Mary his mother, "Behold, this child is destined for the fall and rise of many in Israel, and to be a sign that will be contradicted —and you yourself a sword will pierce— so that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed."

There was also a prophetess, Anna, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was advanced in years, having lived seven years with her husband after her marriage, and then as a widow until she was eighty-four. She never left the temple, but worshiped night and day with fasting and prayer. And coming forward at that very time, she gave thanks to God and spoke about the child to all who were awaiting the redemption of Jerusalem.

When they had fulfilled all the prescriptions of the law of the Lord, they returned to Galilee, to their own town of Nazareth. The child grew and became strong, filled with wisdom; and the favor of God was upon him.
