

The Fourth Week of Advent Represents: Love


Candle Color: Purple

JUBILEE YEAR OF HOPE

The Jubilee Year of Hope will come to a <u>close on December 28th</u>, when Pope Leo XIV will be closing the Holy Door in Rome. If you wish to receive the plenary indulgence associated with this Jubilee Year, you must complete the core requirements before then if you are able. The core requirements are Pilgrimage or pious act: Visit a designated Jubilee site. St. Mary the Immaculate Conception is a designated site. Sacramental Confession: Receive the sacrament of confession within about 20 days of the pious act. Holy Communion: Receive Holy Communion within about 20 days of the pious act. Prayer for the Holy Father's intentions: Pray for the intentions of the Pope. Pope Leo's intention for December is "for Christians in areas of conflict, that they may be seeds of peace, reconciliation, and hope". He asks for prayers for those in the Middle East, as well as in other conflict zones, to support their faith and resilience in the face of suffering. Profession of Faith: Make a profession of faith, such as reciting the Creed.

For most Tuesday evenings, one can attend Adoration at 4:30 pm (a pious act of prayer), attend Mass at 5:30 pm, stay for the Rosary after Mass, and if you let Msgr. David know, receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation. If you are physically unable to complete the core requirements, please ask a member of the clergy what other actions can be taken.




