

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER STEVE

Dear Parishioners and friends,

This weekend brings a flood of emotions as I prepare to step away as your pastor. I will miss all of you. It has truly been an honor and a joy to walk with you during these short years we've shared together. Though brief, they have been some of the most meaningful and grace-filled of my life. From baptizing your children to sharing quiet moments in the confessional, from laughter at parish gatherings to tears at funeral Masses—I've been blessed to stand beside you in the holiest moments of your lives. Over the past few weeks, as I've begun the work of packing and letting go, I've spent time in prayer—honest prayer. And if I'm being honest, I don't want to go. I've felt so welcomed here, so loved, and so at home. But I'm reminded of how Jesus journeyed from town to town, not because He didn't love where He was, but because He was always open to the Father's call to go where He was needed next. That's the example I'm

trying to follow. Like our Lord, I go not because I desire to leave, but because I desire to serve.

When I left my hometown of Evansville, Illinois at age 54, I truly thought that was the hardest thing I'd ever do. I had fully expected to live there all my life, work, pray, have fun, retire, and eventually find my place among six generations of family at St. Boniface Cemetery. But God had other plans. I embraced His will, and He led me to people and places I could never have imagined. He brought me to you. And in doing so, He reminded me that home isn't just where you were born, it's where you are loved. One of the great surprises of priesthood is how love multiplies. I may be leaving this assignment, but the love I carry for you doesn't get packed up in a moving box. It stays with me.

You've left a mark on my priesthood and on my soul. I'll carry your stories, your names, and even your quirks (you know who you are!) with me wherever I go. And don't be surprised if I show up now and then for a fish fry or a school activity, I'm only a few miles away, after all. You will be in good hands. Msgr. Darin is a faithful shepherd, and I know he will lead this parish forward with great heart and vision. Please welcome him as you welcomed me. And please keep me in your prayers, as I will most certainly keep you in mine. We may no longer share the same pews, but we still share the same Church, the same mission, the same Eucharist.

Although I will no longer be your pastor, I will still be in residence at the St. Mary Parish Rectory in Centralia. If you need me, I'm not far:
