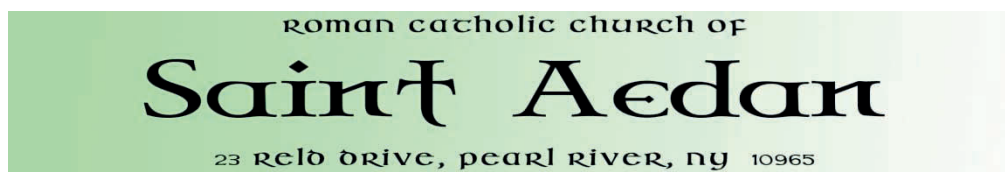

Second Reading: Revelation 21:10-14, 22-23

John depicts Jerusalem coming out of heaven, sparkling with the radiance of precious jewels. Angels were stationed at each of its twelve gates, and each gate bore the name of one tribe of Israel. The city had no temple, because God was its temple. The glory and light of God and the Lamb also replaced their need for the sun.

Gospel: John 14:23-29

Jesus tells his disciples, "Anyone who loves me will be true to my word." For those who do honor his word, both Jesus and God will love them and stay with them always. He also tells them that God will send the Holy Spirit in his place to give them the instructions they will need. Jesus then tells them that peace is his farewell gift to them.

First Reading: Acts 15:1-2, 22-29

Some men informed the Gentiles that they must be circumcised if they wished to be saved, because of the Old Laws. Disciples then went forth to tell the Gentiles to honor only those rules which were strictly necessary, such as abstaining from eating meat sacrificed to idols and illicit sexual union.

From our pastor, Msgr. Emmet Nevin

On Memorial Day, we have a duty to remember, and express our gratitude to the men and women who, regardless of race, color or creed, answered their country's call to leave home and loved ones, their careers or studies and fight around the world and even to die so that we and others, might live in peace. These brave men and women, most of them so very young, served with courage and honor and from the lowest ranked private to the highest ranked general or admiral, they, in the words of Lincoln, ***"gave their last full measure of devotion."*** In the scriptures, we are reminded ***"greater love has no man than he give up his life for a friend."***

On this Memorial Day, we pause to **remember** and to **pray** and to **give thanks** to God who, in the words of sacred scripture, ***"has done great things for us"*** and who is still the one ***"in whom we trust."*** And so, we commend to God's loving care all those who have served and who died whether in the battle fields of the Revolution or the great Civil War; in the Halls of Montezuma or the shores of Tripoli; on a war ship in the Pacific or a landing beach in Normandy; or a snow covered hill in Korea; a rice paddy or jungle in Vietnam or the deadly streets of Iraq or Afghanistan or dozens of other places around the world, including right here on U. S. soil.

This Memorial Day let us pray in the words of Psalm 46,

"God is our refuge and our strength, an ever-present help in distress. Therefore, we fear not, though the earth be shaken, and mountains plunge into the depths of the sea. Though its waters rage and foam and the mountains quake at its surging. The Lord of Hosts is with us, our stronghold is the God of Jacob."

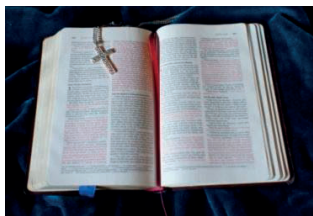

*Find out if **YOUR** unique skills and abilities can help St. Aedan's become a more vibrant, meaningful, fulfilling and inclusive parish for you and for everyone!*



St. Aedan's Ministry of Lector or Minister of the Word is a spirit-based ministry whose purpose is to reveal God's presence in the liturgy of the living Word for our

parish community. Those participating in the Ministry of Lector are called to proclaim the Word of God for Masses offered on Saturdays, Sundays, Holy Days, and other special services.

The commitment to the Ministry of Lector is one which is ongoing throughout the year. This ministry is open to men and women who want to serve. Key components to be a lector are a good speaking voice and a desire to fulfill the duties of the Ministry. Typically, one lector is scheduled for each Mass. Once scheduled, each lector is responsible for finding a substitute lector in the event some conflict arises and he/she is unable to serve at a scheduled Mass. Assignments can be flexible or on a rotational basis.

Training is provided and continues until the candidate is comfortable with the readings and the correct timing of his/her duties. Meetings are held on an as-needed basis.

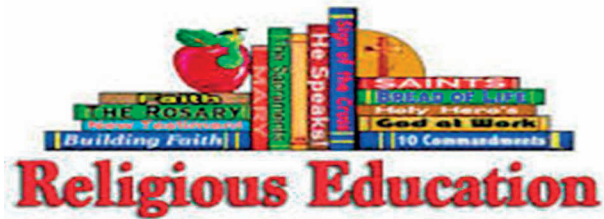

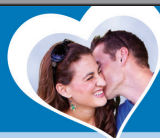
